With this letter we are formally requesting an extension to our contract set to expire on December 31, 2016. We would like to recommend the following changes that would benefit the Village of Steger.

- 1. First, to set the ground work our current price is \$18.64 per month (billed quarterly). That price is scheduled to increase to \$19.47 on January 1, 2016. Should the Village elect to assume the billing on January 1, 2016 we would do the following...

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND GENERAL RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS

THE UNDERSIGNED PARTIES, Willie Cullens ("Cullens") and the Village of Steger (the "Village"), enter into this Settlement Agreement and General Release of All Claims in good faith, as their own free act, and as an arm's-length transaction, as follows:

WHEREAS, Willie Cullens claims that he suffered damage to his 2014 Cadillac CTS ("Cullens' Vehicle") allegedly as the result of repairs made by the Village to Dorsetshire Drive, the street where Cullens resides; and

WHEREAS, the Undersigned Parties wish to completely settle any and all claims that Cullens has or may have in the future against the Village and any of its agents or employees arising out of related to the repairs made by the Village to Dorsetshire Drive; and

WHEREAS, the Village has denied and steadfastly denies any duty or liability whatsoever to Cullens arising out of or related to the repairs made by the Village to Dorsetshire Drive, and any and all other causes and occurrences that have arisen and that may arise, up to and including the date hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Undersigned Parties have reached an agreement to settle all claims that Cullens has or may have against the Village as described hereinabove; and

NOW THEREFORE, for an in consideration of the provisions, covenants, and mutual promises contained herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by the Undersigned Parties, it is hereby agreed by and between the Undersigned Parties as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are incorporated herein by reference;
- 2. In consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-Five Dollars and Sixty-Five Cents (\$2,385.65), as payment for the cost of repairs to Cullen's Vehicle, paid by the Village directly to Gerber Collission & Glass-Bourbannais, 1493 N. State Route 50, Bourbonnais, IL, 60914, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Willie Cullens agrees that:
 - a. To the greatest extent permitted by law, Willie Cullens, for himself and his attorneys, insurers, successors, predecessors, heirs, beneficiaries, and assigns agree(s) to release and forever fully and finally release, waive, compromise, and forever discharge the Village of Steger and its attorneys, officials, trustees, officers, administrators, insurers, employees, agents, successors, heirs, and assigns, jointly and severally, in their individual, official, fiduciary, and corporate capacity (collectively, the "Released Party"), from

any and all claims, liabilities, suits, injuries, demands, debts, liens, damages, actions, or rights of action he may have, as of the date of execution of this settlement and release, whether known or unknown, liquidated or unliquidated, absolute or contingent, in law or in equity, arising from or related to the repairs made by the Village to Dorsetshire Drive, or from any other occurrence or situation as of the date of execution of this settlement and release.

- 3. <u>Attorney Fees and Expenses</u>. The Undersigned Parties agree that each will pay their own respective attorneys' fees, costs, disbursements, and expenses.
- 4. <u>Neutral Construction</u>. The language shall in all cases be construed as a whole, according to its fair meaning, and not strictly for or against any of the Undersigned Parties regardless of who drafted this Settlement Agreement and Release.
- 5. <u>Complete Agreement</u>. This Settlement Agreement and Release sets forth all of the terms and conditions of the agreement between the Undersigned Parties concerning the subject matter hereof and any prior oral communications are superseded by this Settlement Agreement and Release. The Undersigned Parties understand and agree that all of the terms and promises of this Settlement Agreement and Release, other than the "Whereas" clauses, which are information, are contractual and not a mere recital.
- 6. <u>Effect on Previous Agreements</u>. This Settlement Agreement and Release supersedes any and all prior agreements, understandings and communications between the Undersigned Parties.
- 7. <u>Amendment</u>. This Settlement Agreement and Release may be amended only by a written document signed by the Undersigned Parties; and
- 8. <u>Severability</u>. In the event that any of the provisions of this Settlement Agreement and Release are found by a judicial or other tribunal to be unenforceable, the remaining provisions of this Settlement Agreement and Release will, at the Undersigned Parties' discretion, remain enforceable.
- 9. <u>Nonadmission</u>. This Settlement Agreement and Release is being entered into solely for the purpose of settling the disputed claims of Willie Cullens against the Village, and shall not be construed as: (a) an admission by the Released Party of any (i) liability or wrongdoing, (ii) breach of any agreement, or (iii) violation of a statute, law or regulation; or (b) a waiver of any defenses as to those matters within the scope of this Settlement Agreement and Release. The Village specifically denies any liability or wrongdoing, and Willie Cullens agrees that he will not state, suggest or

- imply the contrary to anyone, either directly or indirectly, whether through counsel or otherwise; and
- 10. <u>Acknowledgement</u>. The Undersigned Parties declare that they have had the opportunity to and did negotiate over the terms of the Settlement Agreement and Release and have completely read this Settlement Agreement and Release. The Undersigned Parties fully understand its terms and contents, including the rights and obligations hereunder, and freely, voluntarily, and without coercion enter into this Settlement Agreement and Release. The Undersigned Parties acknowledge that they had the right to consult with an attorney before signing this Settlement Agreement and Release.
- 11. <u>Counterparts</u>. This Settlement Agreement and Release may be executed in Counterparts, each of which shall be an original and all of which together shall constitute one and the same document.
- 12. <u>Choice of Law.</u> The Undersigned Parties agree that this Settlement Agreement and Release shall be deemed to have been executed an delivered within the State of Illinois and shall in all respects be governed, interpreted and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois exclusive of its conflicts of law provisions.




