AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COMPENSATION SCHEDULE FOR A CERTAIN EMPLOYEE OF THE VILLAGE OF STEGER.

WHEREAS, the Village of Steger, Counties of Cook and Will, State of Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village President (the "President") and Board of Trustees of the Village (the "Village Board" and together with the President, the "Corporate Authorities") are committed to adopting employment policies necessary to ensure the efficient operation of the Village; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the foregoing, the Corporate Authorities previously adopted a compensation schedule, effective January 1, 2015, (the "2015 Compensation Schedule") for Village employees and non-elected officials designed to ensure that the Village remains able to attract and retain qualified personnel to provide governmental services; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities previously determined that it was necessary, advisable and in the best interests of the Village to delay making adjustments to a certain employee's wages until May 1, 2015; and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is in the best interests of the Village and its residents to amend the

2015 Compensation Schedule to reflect an adjustment of wages, effective as of May 1, 2015, for the employee and in such amount as are set forth on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Steger, Counties of Cook and Will, and the State of Illinois, as follows:

ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL

SECTION 1: Incorporation Clause.

The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance as legislative findings.

SECTION 2: Purpose.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend the 2015 Compensation Schedule to reflect an adjustment of wages, effective as of May 1, 2015, for the employee and in such amount as are set forth on Exhibit A.

ARTICLE II. AUTHORIZATION

Section 3.00 Authorization.

The Corporate Authorities hereby authorize and approve the amendment of the 2015 Compensation Schedule in accordance with Exhibit A. The Village Board further authorizes and directs the President or his designee to execute any and all documentation that may be necessary to carry out the intent of this Ordinance. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest to and countersign any documentation as may be necessary to carry out and effectuate the purpose of this Ordinance. The Village Clerk is also authorized and directed to affix the Seal of the

Village to such documentation as is deemed necessary. The officers, employees and/or agents of the Village shall take all action necessary or reasonably required to carry out, give effect to and consummate the purpose of this Ordinance and shall take all action necessary in conformity therewith. The officers, employees and/or agents of the Village are specifically authorized and directed to draft and disseminate any and all necessary forms required in connection herewith. All prior actions consistent with the intent of this Ordinance are hereby ratified. This Ordinance shall not affect the compensation of any employee not set forth on Exhibit A, including any employee whose terms and conditions of employment with the Village are governed by a collective bargaining agreement.

ARTICLE III. HEADINGS, SAVINGS CLAUSES, PUBLICATION, EFFECTIVE DATE

SECTION: 4 Headings.

The headings of the articles, sections, paragraphs and subparagraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Ordinance nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provision of this Ordinance.

SECTION: 5 Severability.

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision of this Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable and as though not provided for herein, and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect.

SECTION: 6 Superseder.

To the extent that the provisions of this Ordinance are inconsistent with any

other Village code provision, ordinance, resolution, rule, proclamation, enactment,

pronouncement, document, instrument or understanding governing or in any other

way related to the subject matter of this Ordinance such conflicting authority shall be

superseded by this Ordinance to the fullest extent permitted by law.

SECTION: 7 Publication.

A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in

pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the

Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

SECTION: 8 Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall be effective and in full force immediately upon passage

and approval.
