

## Coliform Monitoring Violation Template

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

#### Monitoring Requirements Not Met for 0314860

Our water system violated several drinking water standards over the past year. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct these situations.

*We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During 7/1/15 to 7/31/15 we did not complete all monitoring or testing for total coliform and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.*

#### What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the contaminant(s) we did not properly test for during the last year, how often we are supposed to sample for total coliform and how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which follow-up samples were (or will be) taken.

#### What happened? What is being done?

The Village submitted the required samples in July 2015. The samples were sent priority mail to the State EPA lab for testing. The samples were received expired and resampling was necessary. The new samples were resent to the State EPA lab for testing via priority mail, but were not received.

The Village of Steger is now hand delivering samples to a State of Illinois approved lab to prevent and problems in the future.
