MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF STEGER, WILL & COOK COUNTIES, ILLINOIS

The Board of Trustees convened in regular session at 7:00 P.M. on this 4TH day of February, 2019 in the Municipal Building of the Village of Steger with the Village President Kenneth A. Peterson presiding and Deputy Village Clerk Sandy Mehrl attending. President Peterson led all in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Deputy Village Clerk Mehrl called the roll. The following Trustees were present, Joyce, Perchinski, Kozy, Lopez, Skrezyna and Buxton.

Also present were: Village Administrator Mary Jo Seehausen, Police Chief Patrick Rossi, Director of Public Infrastructure Dave Toepper, Fire Chief Nowell Fillion, EMA Chief Tom Johnston, Community Center Director Diane Rossi and Director of Housing and Community Development Alice Peterson.

AWARDS, HONORS AND SPECIAL RECOGNITION

Police Chief Rossi promoted Detective Peter Fajman to the rank of Sergeant. Members of the Police and Fire Board administered the oath of office and Sgt. Fajman was congratulated by all.

MINUTES

Trustee Lopez made a motion to approve the minutes of the January 22, 2019 meeting as written. Trustee Perchinski seconded the motion. Voice vote was called; all ayes. Motion carried.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION

Michael Balanow of 3328 Florence Ave., Mary Laws of 3437 Jennifer Ct, Tom McComb of 3303 Wallace and Loren Harn of 3328 Halsted St. all voiced concerns and disapproval regarding Resolution 1132, the installation of Red Light Cameras. Vicki Kaiser of 3436 Jennifer Ct. thanked the Village and ESDA for the plowing efforts and weather updates. She asked why K-Mart lot was plowed now that it is vacant. Director of Public Infrastructure Toepper answered it was done for safety reasons. She also stated her disapproval of putting in the solar farm due to it giving up land that would not generate revenue for the Village.

Village Administrator Mary Jo Seehausen thanked everyone who helped with recent weather related issues. She announced the Village Hall has hired Noel Betczynski to our staff. She stated that Citgo is waiting on construction time lines and work with the Union Pacific is moving along. She also advised we are working with Locis on the new payroll time clock system and hope to have it for our first payroll in March.

Director of Public Infrastructure Dave Toepper had no report, but did state they have fixed 6 water main breaks and have had many water meters freeze in houses that they have had calls on during the cold weather.

Fire Chief Nowell Fillion welcomed two new employees, Katilyn Garcia and Bailey Stevenson. He thanked the Village for putting on extra man power to help out on the recent weather issues.

Police Chief Patrick Rossi referred to his weekly report and also thanked all the first responders during the cold weather issues.

EMA Chief Tom Johnston stated they had warming shelter open for approximately 5 hours during the power outage and they assisted the Colonies with a broken water pipe.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Trustee Perchinski made a motion to adopt Resolution1132, A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF STEGER AND SENSYS GATSO USA, INC. TO PROVIDE SERVICES FOR THE VILLAGE OF STEGER, ILLINOIS, with the understanding the Village will not owe any money at the end of the term. Trustee Joyce seconded the motion stating for him it is a safety issue, and that money generated will go to the Police Pension Fund. Trustee Perchinski amended his motion to include all monies from the camera are to go to the Police Pension Fund. Roll was called. The following Trustees voted aye: Joyce, Perchinski, Kozy, and Buxton. Trustees voting no: Lopez and Skrezyna. Mayor Peterson voted aye. Motion carried.

Trustee Perchinski made a motion to deny ORDINANCE 1208, AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN A SOLAR FARM IN THE VILLAGE OF STEGER, ILLINOIS. Motion was seconded by Trustee Buxton. Roll was called. The following Trustees voted aye: Joyce, In the middle of roll call a representative of the Solar Farm came forward and asked to give a presentation. The representative clarified that the Village was to deny the Ordinance. He stated that Village was putting themselves in jeopardy by overriding the zoning boards recommendation. Mayor Peterson informed him of a covenant against the land filed February 4, 2010. The representative stated that they have put the solar farm behind a gas pipe line and have allowed 40 acres for retail and have made it well clear of any possible off ramps being put in. Trustee Perchinski at this point amended his motion to table indefinitely to get legal review. Trustee Joyce seconded the motion and a voice vote was called; all ayes. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT TO ENTER INTO A CERTAIN AMENDMENT WITH VERTICAL BRIDGE NTCF, LLC TO AMEND A CERTAIN GROUND LEASE FOR THE VILLAGE OF STEGER.

WHEREAS, the Village of Steger, Counties of Cook and Will, State of Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village President (the "President") and Board of Trustees of the Village (the "Village Board" and together with the President, the "Corporate Authorities") are committed to ensuring the effective administration of government and promoting the health, safety and general welfare of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the foregoing, the Corporate Authorities previously entered into a ground lease (the "Ground Lease") with U.S Cellular Operating Company of Chicago, LLC ("U.S. Cellular") pursuant to which U.S. Cellular leased certain land owned by the Village (the "Premises"); and

WHEREAS, U.S. Cellular previously assigned the Ground Lease to VB Midwest I, LLC ("VB Midwest"); and

WHEREAS, VB Midwest previously assigned the Ground Lease to Vertical Bridge NTCF, LLC ('Vertical Bridge"); and

WHEREAS, Vertical Bridge has proposed that the Ground Lease be amended to expand the Premises, to allow for the subleasing of the Premises, and to increase the amount of base rent paid to the Village by Vertical Bridge; and

WHEREAS, Vertical Bridge has provided the Village with an amendment to the Ground Lease (the "Amendment"), a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A, setting forth the terms and conditions under which Vertical Bridge will continue to lease the Premises; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is in the best interests of the Village and its residents to approve, execute, and enter into an agreement with terms substantially the same as the terms of the Amendment; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Steger, Counties of Cook and Will, and the State of Illinois, as follows:

ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL

SECTION 1: Incorporation Clause.

The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this Resolution are full, true, and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Resolution as legislative findings.

SECTION 2: Purpose.

The purpose of this Resolution is to authorize the President or his designee to enter into and approve the Amendment whereby Vertical Bridge will continue to lease the Premises from the Village, to further authorize the President or his designee to take all steps necessary to carry out the terms of the Amendment and to ratify any steps taken to effectuate those goals.

ARTICLE II. AUTHORIZATION

SECTION 3: Authorization.

The Village Board hereby authorizes and directs the President or his designee to enter into and approve the Amendment in accordance with its terms, or any modification thereof, and to ratify any and all previous action taken to effectuate the intent of this Resolution. The Village Board authorizes and directs the President or his designee to execute the applicable Amendment, with such insertions, omissions, and changes as shall be approved by the President and the Village Attorney. The Village Board further authorizes the President or his designee to execute any and all additional documentation that may be necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest to and countersign any documentation as may be necessary to carry out and effectuate the purpose of this Resolution. The Village Clerk is also authorized and directed to affix the Seal of the Village to such documentation as is deemed necessary.

ARTICLE III. HEADINGS, SAVINGS CLAUSES, PUBLICATION, EFFECTIVE DATE

SECTION: 4 Headings.

The headings of the articles, sections, paragraphs, and subparagraphs of this Resolution are inserted solely for convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Resolution nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provision of this Resolution.

SECTION: 5 Severability.

The provisions of this Resolution are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision of this Resolution be determined to be in conflict with any law,

statute, or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable, and as though not provided for herein, and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid, and in full force and effect.

SECTION: 6 Superseder.

All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions, rules, and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

SECTION: 7 Publication.

A full, true, and complete copy of this Resolution shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

SECTION: 8 Effective Date.

This Resolution shall be effective and in full force immediately upon passage and approval.
