MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
VILLAGE OF STEGER, WILL & COOK
COUNTIES, ILLINOIS

The Board of Trustees convened in regular session at 7:00 P.M. on this 5th day of August, 2019 in the Municipal Building of the Village of Steger with the Village President Kenneth A Peterson, Jr presiding. President Peterson led all in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Village Clerk Joseph M. Zagone, Jr. called the roll. The following Trustees were present, Joyce, Perchinski, Kozy, Lopez, Skrezyna, Buxton and Mayor Peterson.

Also present were: Village Administrator Mary Jo Seehausen, Director of Public Infrastructure Dave Toepper, Fire Chief Nowell Fillion, Police Chief Patrick Rossi, EMA Chief Tom Johnston and Community Center Director Diane Rossi. Housing and Community Development Director Alice Peterson

MINUTES

Trustee Perchinski made a motion to approve the minutes of the July 1st meeting as written. Trustee Skrezyna seconded the motion. Voice vote. All Trustees present voted aye. Motion carried.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION

Mayor Peterson opened the audience participation portion of the meeting by asking to move his part of the agenda to precede audience participation. Trustee Perchinski made a motion to move the Mayor's comments to precede audience participation. Trustee Buxton seconded the motion. Voice vote. All Trustees present voted aye. Motion carried.

The Mayor opened his comments acknowledging that a lot of people present want to know what has been happening since the flood and the process that we are going through. The village is working hard to try and find ways to get water out of our community. We are working on a major drainage plan for the Village of Steger. We already have one study and are updating so we can go to Metropolitan Water Reclamation District to get funding to start working on some of this. We are also working on a 5-year road plan. Need to fix the flooding first than the roads. All of this takes money, and the Village is limited on funds. We are going to the state and both counties trying to find help, and MWRD to find additional funding. It is important that you all know that we are working to find a solution. We have collected a lot of

information regarding the recent flood, it has gone through both counties, the state and on to the federal government. The federal government has informed us that we do not meet the requirements for FEMA funds. We have not heard from the state yet, but we have heard from some not-for-profits that have reached out to us. The Red Cross and others are developing qualifications for getting aid.

Julie Stone presented a history of flooding at their home going back to 2004. They have flooded once and sometimes twice a year since. Mrs. Stone described damage and costs that they continue to incur because of these 100-year storms that hit very frequently. She believes they have done all they can to protect their property to no avail. She is asking for more information regarding what steps the Village is planning to help with this problem. Mayor Peterson stated that it is not that we have done nothing, but we are limited in funds for doing the improvements that recent studies suggest.

Harry Hammock approached the board and asked if Steger is part of IRMA. We are not. He questioned if the Village has contacted Thorn Creek Basin. Mayor Peterson stated that he had not sat down with them yet, but Thorn Creek claims they do not control storm drainage. He questioned Red Cross help and wondered how many homes were affected and EMA Chief Johnson stated that it was over 300. Mr. Hammock addressed the engineering survey and things that could have been done. Mayor Peterson pointed out that the fix has to start in the east and work west. Mr. Hammock is concerned about putting money back into his home and is concerned with the Villages liability.

George Bolos presented information regarding his property on Chicago Road that is adjacent to the new Citco station on Chicago Road and Steger Road. He claims he was not given written notification as required by law of construction of the new gas station that he believes is affecting his building. He voiced many concerns regarding surveys and construction.

Carol Lindemann questioned whether our retention ponds are kept clean. The Mayor stated that they are clean, but we need to address them. Dave Toepper said he would look at them.

Jerry Iafollo addressed issues with speeding cars on Phillips Avenue between 34th St. and 35th St. Mr. Iafollo gave the board a proposal for 3 speed bumps along this stretch of roadway. The Village will evaluate the proposal. He also pointed out issues on 35th St in the morning during school hours that more stop signs are needed to slow cars in the area of the school.

Dan Cicale addressed the drainage issues in Miller Woods and questioned what the plan is for that area. It is part of the plan that is being prepared for MWRD.

Michael Porter approached the board regarding weeds that are overgrown on Lisa Lane and Oakland Drive causing vision issues for drivers, runners and walkers. Additionally, he addressed the condition of roads in Royal Oak Subdivision. He questioned if the Village is involved in the "Roll Program" for fixing roads. Some damaged asphalt has been fixed, but others ignored. Dave Toepper will look into why they would fix some bad spots and leave others and will address the overgrown grass issue.

Winona Johnson of Royal Oak Estates. She questioned if there were flood gates in Steger, and the Mayor stated that there are no flood gates in Steger. Thorn Creek has flood gates which may or may not have played a part, but we are still investigating. She also questioned the pond on Oakland Drive that rises to the street when it rains real hard.

Village Administrator Mary Jo Seehausen voiced appreciation for everyone who reached out to her and her husband Tom regarding the death of his dad Tom Seehausen Sr., former Village Trustee in Steger.

Director of Public Infrastructure Dave Toepper No report.

Fire Chief Nowell Fillion thanked all the POC's that came out to help on the night of the flood. They made a big difference in helping keep loss at a minimum. Chief Fillion also presented plans to replace the existing ladder truck that is in need of repairs with a newer model that is in much better condition for about the same cost as repairing the current rig.

Police Chief Patrick Rossi pointed out that Tuesday August 6, 2019 is National Night Out for 1st Responders. There will be demonstrations and activities.

EMA Chief Tom Johnston As of last week we have 320 homes damaged in the flood. Cook County may have more to add.

Community Center Director Diane Rossi Reported that they held their Summer Picnic for all the kids that participated in Summer Club. There were about 60 people there and many activities. Thank you to the Village and all the volunteers.

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING AUTHORITY TO THE VILLAGE ADMINSTRATOR
TO RENUMBER ORDINANCES FOR THE VILLAGE OF STEGER, ILLINOIS.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Steger, Counties of Cook and Will, State of Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, from time to time clerical errors may result in the misnumbering of ordinances approved by the Village; and

WHEREAS, the President and the Board of Trustees (collectively, the "Corporate Authorities") believe that it is in the best interest of the Village to grant authority to the Village Administrator to renumber Village ordinances when necessary; and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the Corporate Authorities have deemed it necessary to provide such authority in the interest of effective governance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Steger, Counties of Cook and Will, and the State of Illinois, as follows:

**ARTICLE I.
IN GENERAL**

SECTION 1.0: Incorporation Clause.

The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance as legislative findings.

SECTION 2.0: Purpose.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to provide the authority to the Village Administrator to renumber ordinances when appropriate, in the interest of effective governance.

**ARTICLE III.
HEADINGS, SAVINGS CLAUSES, PUBLICATION,
EFFECTIVE DATE**

SECTION 4.0: Headings.

The headings of the articles, sections, paragraphs and subparagraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Ordinance nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provision of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5.0: Severability.

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision of this Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable and as though not provided for herein, and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect.

SECTION 6.0: Superseder.

All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions, rules and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

SECTION 7.0: Publication.

A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

SECTION 8.0: Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall be effective and in full force after its passage, approval and publication in accordance with applicable law.
