AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE PURCHASE AND FINANCING OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY FOR THE VILLAGE OF STEGER, COUNTIES OF COOK AND WILL, STATE OF ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, the Village of Steger, Counties of Cook and Will, State of Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the President and the Village Board of Trustees (collectively, the "Corporate Authorities") have deemed it advisable, necessary and in the public interest of the Village to acquire the following described personal property: three (3) 2020 Ford Utility Interceptors (the "Vehicles") and necessary equipment modifications (the "Equipment"), as each are described in Group Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, the Vehicles and Equipment will serve the public and corporate purposes for which the Village is organized; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby estimated and determined that the Vehicles and Equipment will cost approximately \$129,522.90 the ("Purchase Price"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 11-61-3 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-61-3), the Village is authorized to purchase real and personal property for public purposes pursuant to contracts which provide for the consideration for such purchase to be paid in monthly installments during a period not exceed twenty (20) years; and

WHEREAS, Old Plank Trail Community Bank, N.A. ("Old Plank Trail") has agreed to lend money to the Village to pay the Purchase Price for the Vehicles and Equipment, payable in installments; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11-61-3 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-61-3), it necessary that the Corporate Authorities adopt an ordinance authorizing and approving the purchase of the Vehicles and Equipment and authorizing the Village to borrow money from Old Plank Trail in the amount of the Purchase Price, payable to Old Plank Trail in installments over forty-eight (48) months at an interest rate of 3.3% (the "Loan");

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Steger, Counties of Cook and Will and State of Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: The statements set forth in the preamble to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are incorporated into this Ordinance as if set forth in full.

SECTION 2: The Corporate Authorities hereby find and determine that it is necessary and advisable and otherwise in the best interests of the Village to purchase the Vehicles and Equipment, as described on Group Exhibit A attached hereto, and to authorize the Loan for the payment of the Purchase Price, which shall be payable in forty-eight (48) monthly installments at an interest rate of 3.3%.

SECTION 3: The Loan and the purchase of the Vehicles and Equipment are hereby approved. The President, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to approve and execute such documents as are required to effectuate the Loan as described by this Ordinance, with such insertions, omissions and changes as shall be approved by the President and the Village Attorney. The Corporate Authorities further authorize the President, or his designee, to approve and execute such documents as

are required to effectuate the purchase of the Vehicles and the Equipment, as set forth in Group Exhibit A. The Corporate Authorities further authorize the President, or his designee, to execute any and all additional documentation that may be necessary to carry out the intent of this Ordinance, including, but not limited to, any and all loan documents, certificates, and purchase agreements. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest to and countersign any such documents, as required.

SECTION 4: For the purposes of providing funds to pay the installments of interest and principal due on the Loan, when and as the same fall due, the Village shall maintain sufficient funds on hand from hand ad valorem taxes.

SECTION 5: All prior actions of the Village's officials, employees and agents with respect to the subject matter of this Ordinance are hereby expressly ratified.

SECTION 5: The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and should any provision of this Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable and as though not provided for herein, and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect.

SECTION 6: All ordinances, resolutions, rules and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

SECTION 7: This Ordinance shall be immediately in full force and effect after passage, approval and publication. A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.





GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1. Nature of Work. Clark Roofing Company ("Clark") shall furnish the labor and material necessary to perform the work described herein or in the referenced contract documents. Clark does not provide engineering, architectural, design or consulting services. It is the Owner's responsibility to retain a licensed architect or engineer to provide proper design and code compliance, including determining whether a vapor or air retarder is needed. If plans, specifications or other design documents have been furnished to Clark, Customer warrants that they are sufficient and conform to all applicable laws and building codes. Clark is not responsible for loss, damage or expense due to defects in plans or specifications or building code violations unless such damage results from a deviation by Clark from what is specifical. Clark is not responsible for condensation, moisture migration from the building interior or other building components, location or size of roof drains, adequacy of drainage, ponding on the roof, structural conditions or the properties of the roof deck or substrate on which Clark's roofing work is installed.
- 2. Deck Condition. Customer warrants that structures on which Clark is to work are in sound condition and capable of withstanding roofing construction, equipment and operations. Clark's commencement of roof installation indicates only that Clark has visually inspected the surface of the roof deck for visible defects. Clark is not responsible for the structural sufficiency, quality of construction (including compliance with FMG criteria), undulations, fastening or moisture content of the roof deck or other trades' work or design.
- 3. Concrete Decks. In the event that roofing is to be installed over a concrete or other wet deck or substrate, the determination as to when the concrete or wat substrate is sufficiently cured and dried so that roofing materials can be installed without potential future adverse effect shall be made by others. Clark is not responsible to test or assess moisture content of the deck or substrate.
- 4. Asbestos and Toxic Materials. This proposal is based on Clark's not coming into contact with asbestos-containing materials, lead-based paint or toxic materials ("ACM"). Clark is not responsible for expenses, claims or damages arising out of the presence, disturbance or removal of ACM. Clark shall be compensated for additional expenses resulting from the presence of ACM. Customer agrees to indemnify Clark from and against any liability, damages, losses, claims, demands or citations arising out of the presence of ACM.
- 5. Payment. Unless stated otherwise on the face of this proposal, Customer shall pay a 25% deposit prior to start of work and Customer shall pay the balance of the contract price plus any additional charges for changed or extra work within ten (10) days of substantial completion of the Work. If completion of the Work extends beyond one month, Customer shall make monthly progress payments to Clark by or before the fifth (5th) day of each month for the value of Work completed during the preceding month, plus the value of materials suitably stored for the project. Clark's entitlement to payment is not dependent upon criteria promulgated by Factory Mutual Global, including wind uplif testing.
- 6. Non-Payment. All sums not paid when due shall earn interest at the rate of 1-1/2% per month. Clark shall be entitled to recover from Customer all costs of collection incurred by Clark, including attorney's fees, resulting from Customer's failure to make proper payment when due. Collection matters may be processed through litigation or arbitration at Clark's discretion.
- 7. Right to Stop Work. The failure of Customer to make proper payment to Clark when due shall, in addition to all other rights, constitute a material breach of contract and shall entitle Clark, at its discretion, to suspend all work and shipments, including furnishing werranty, until full payment its made. The time period in which Clark shall perform the work shall be extended for a period equal to the period during which the Work was suspended, and the contract sum to be paid Clark shall be increased by the amount of Clark's reasonable costs of shut-down, delay and start-up.
- 8. Insurance. Clark shall carry worker's compensation, automobile and commercial general liability insurance. Clark will furnish a Certificate of Insurance, evidencing the types and amounts of its coverages, upon request. Customer shall purchase and maintain builder's risk and property insurance, including the labor and materials furnished by Clark, covering fire, extended coverage, malicious mischief, vandalism and theft on the premises to protect against loss or damage to material and equipment and partially completed work until the job is completed and accepted. Moneys owed to Clark shall not be withheld by reason of any damage or claim against Clark covered by liability or property damage insurance maintained by Clark or claims covered under builder's risk insurance.
- 9. Additional insured. If Customer requires and Clark agrees to name Customer or others as additional insureds on Clark's liability insurance policy, Customer and Clark agree that the naming of Customer or others as additional insureds is intended to apply to claims made against the additional insured to the extent the claim is due to the negligence of Clark and is not intended to make the Clark's insurer liable for claims that are due to the fault of the additional insured.
- 10. Interior Protection. Customer acknowledges that re-roofing of an existing building may cause disturbance, dust or debris to fall into the interior or damage to a ceiling that is attached to the roof deck. Customer agrees to remove or protect property directly below the roof in order to minimize potential interior damage. Clark shall not be responsible for disturbance, damage, clean up or loss to interior property that Customer did not remove or protect prior to commencement of roofing operations or ceiling damage due to removal of existing materials, deflection or normal roofing operations. Customer shall notify occupants and tenants of re-roofing and the need to provide protection underneath areas being re-roofed. Customer agrees to hold Clark harmless from claims of occupants and tenants who were not so notified and did not provide protection.
- 11. Site Conditions. Clark shall not be responsible for additional costs required due to the existence of utilities, wet insulation, deteriorated deck or other subsurface or latent conditions unless specifically identified and covered in the scope of work when the contract was executed. The raising, disconnection, re-connection or relocation of any mechanical equipment on the roof that may be necessary for Clark to perform the roofing work shall be performed by others or treated as an extra.
- 12. Deck Repairs. Any work required to replace rotten or missing wood or deteriorated decking shall be done on a labor and material or unit price basis as an extra unless specifically included in the scope of work.
- 13. Working Hours. This proposal is based upon the performance of all work during Clark's regular hours. Extra charges will be made for overtime and all work performed other than during Clark's regular working hours, if required by Customer.
- 14. Damages and Delays. Clark will not be responsible for damage done to Clark's work by others, including damage to temporary tie-ins that if damaged may allow for water entry. Any repairing of the same by Clark will be charged as an extra. Clark shall not be liable for liquidated or delay damages due to a delay in completion of the Project unless the delay was caused by Clark. Clark shall not be responsible for loss, damage or delay caused by circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, accidents, snow, fire, weather, vandalism, regulation, strikes, jurisdictional disputes, failure or delay of transportation, shortage of or inability to obtain materials, equipment or labor, in the event of these occurrences, Clark's time for performance shall be extended for a time sufficient to
- permit completion of the Work.

 15. Roof Projections. Clark will flash roof penetrations that are in place prior to this proposal or shown

- on architectural plans provided to Clark prior to submittal of this proposal. Additional penetrations shall be considered an order for extra work and Clark shall be compensated at its customary time and material rates.
- 16. Wind Loads and Fire Ratings. Design Professional is responsible to design the work to be in compliance with applicable codes and regulations and to specify or show the work that is to be performed. Clark is not responsible for design, including calculation of wind-load design and fire resistance. To the extent uplift pressures or fire ratings are required, Clark's proposal is based solely on manufacturer's printed data. Clark itself makes no representation regarding wind uplift capacity or fire resistance capability and assumes no liability for wind uplift or fire resistance.
- 17. Fumes and Emissions. Customer acknowledges that odors and emissions from roofing products will be released as part of the roofing operations to be performed by Clark. Customer shall be responsible for interior air quality, including controlling mechanical equipment, HVAC units, intake vents, wall vents, windows, doors and other openings to prevent fumes and odors from entering the building. Customer is aware that roofing products emit fumes, vapors and odors during the application process. Some people are more sensitive to these emissions than others. Customer shall hold Clark hamless from claims from third parties relating to fumes and odors that are emitted during the normal roofing process.
- 18. Material Cost Escalation. Steel products, asphalt, polyisocyanurate and other roofing products are sometimes subject to unusual price volatility due to conditions that are beyond the control or anticipation of Clark. If there is a substantial increase in these or other roofing products between the date of this proposal and the time when the work is to be performed, the amount of the contract may be increased to reflect the additional cost to the roofing Clark, upon submittal of written documentation and advance notice.
- 19. Backcharges. No backcharges or claims for payment of services rendered or materials and equipment furnished by Customer to Clark shall be valid unless previously authorized in writing by Clark and unless written notice is given to Clark within five (5) days of the event, act or omission which is the basis of the backcharge.
- 20. Safety. Owner warrants there will be no five power lines on or near the roof servicing the building where Clark will be working and that Owner will arrange to turn off any such power supplies to avoid an electrocution risk to Clark's employees. Clark's price is based upon there not being electrical conduit or other materials embedded within the roof assembly or attached directly to the underside or topside of the roof deck upon which Clark will be installing the new roof. Customer will indemnify Clark from personal injury and other claims and expenses if Customer fails to turn-off power so as to avoid injury to Clark's personnel or rasulting from the presence of concealed electrical conduit and live electrical power. Clark is not responsible for costs of repair or damages, including disruption of service, resulting from damage to undisclosed or concealed electrical or other utility lines. Customer shall shut down roof located electronic equipment that emits or receives radio frequency waves while roofing contractor is to be working on the roof so that roofing personnel will not be subject to radio frequency waves or electromagnetic radiation while working on the roof and shall indemnify and hold Clark and its personnel harmless from any personal injury claims resulting from a failure by Customer to do so. Clark is not responsible for the safety of persons on the roof other than its own employees. Customer and general contractor agree to indemnify and hold Clark hamless, including attorney's fees, from claims for personal injury by persons or entities whom owner or general contractor have allowed or authorized to be on the roof.
- 21. Availability of Site. Clark shall be provided with direct access to the work site for the passage of trucks and materials and direct access to the roof. Clark shall not be required to begin work until underlying areas are ready and acceptable to receive Clark's work and sufficient areas of roof deck are clear and available and free from snow, water or debris to allow for continuous full operation. The expense of any extra trips by Clark to and from the job as a result of the job not being ready for the Work after Clark has been notified to proceed will be charged as an extra.
- 22. Warranty. Clark's work will be warranted by Clark in accordance with its standard warranty, which is made a part of this proposal and contract and incorporated by reference. A facsimile of Clark's standard warranty is attached or, if not, will be furnished upon request. Clark SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES. The acceptance of this proposal by the Customer signifies his agreement that this warranty shall be and is the exclusive remedy against Clark.

A manufacturer's warranty shall be furnished to Customer if a manufacturer's warranty is called for on the face of this proposal. It is expressly agreed that in the event of alleged defects in the materials furnished pursuant to this contract, Customer shall have recourse only against the manufacturer of such material.

- 23. Existing Conditions. Clark is not responsible for leakage through the existing roof or other portions of the building that have not yet been reroofed by Clark.
- 24. Mold. Owner will make periodic inspections for signs of water intrusion and act promptly including prompt notice to Clark if Owner believes there are roof leak. Owner is responsible for monitoring any leak areas and for indoor air quality. Clark is not responsible for indoor air quality, mold, mildew or any alleged injury resulting therefrom. Owner shall hold harmless and indemnify Clark from claims due to indoor air quality and resulting from a failure by Owner to maintain the building in a manner to avoid growth of mold.
- 25. Material References. Clark is not responsible for the actual verification of technical specifications of product manufacturers; i.e., R-value or ASTM or UL compliance, but rather the materials used are represented as such by the material manufacturer.
- 28. Tolerances. All labor and materials shall be furnished in accordance with normal industry standards and industry tolerances for uniformity, color, variation, thickness, size, weight, finish and texture. Specified quantities are intended to represent an average over the entire roof area.
- 27. Oil-canning. Metal roofing and especially lengthy flat-span sheet-metal panels often will exhibit waviness, commonly referred to as "oil-canning." The degree of oil-canning and the appearance of the panels will vary depending on factor such as the length and color of the panels, alloy, gauge, galvanizing process, substrate condition, and exposure to sunlight. Oil-canning pertains to aesthetics and not the performance of the panels and is not controlled by the roofing Clark. The type of metal roofing panels specified can affect the degree of oil-canning. Clark is not responsible for oil-canning or aesthetics. Oil-canning shall not be grounds to withhold payment or reject panels of the type specified.
- 28. Dispute Resolution. If a dispute shall arise between Clark and Customer with respect to any matters or questions arising out of or relating to this Agreement or the breach thereof. Clark and Customer will seek to mediate the dispute. If mediation is not successful, arbitration shall be administered by and conducted in accordance with the Construction Industry Arbitration Rules of the American Arbitration Association unless the parties mutually agree otherwise. This Agreement to arbitrate shall be specifically enforceable under the prevailing arbitration law. The award rendered by the arbitrators shall be final, and judgment may be entered upon it in any Court having jurisdiction thereof. Any legal claim against Clark elleging any breach of this contract or negligence by Clark must be initiated no later than two (2) years after Clark performed the roofing installation covered by this contract.
