# MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF STEGER, WILL & COOK COUNTIES, ILLINOIS

The Board of Trustees convened in regular session at 7:00 P.M. on this 14<sup>th</sup> day of January 2021 in the Municipal Building of the Village of Steger and via Teleconference that was made available to all residents. Mayor Peterson led all in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Village Clerk Joseph M. Zagone, Jr. called the roll. The following Trustees were present, Joyce, Kozy, Lopez, Skrezyna and Buxton and Mayor Peterson. Trustee Perchinski joined via ZOOM at 7:19 P.M.

Also present: Village Administrator Mary Jo Seehausen and Fire Chief Nowell Fillion were present. Director of Public Infrastructure Dave Toepper, Police Chief Kevin Shaughnessy and EMA Chief Tom Johnston were present via ZOOM.

#### **AWARDS, HONORS AND SPECIAL RECOGNITION**

The appointment of Part Time Officer Gino Fimbianti has been postponed to the first meeting in February.

#### **MINUTES**

Trustee Lopez made a motion to approve the minutes of the December 21st meeting as written. Trustee Skrezyna seconded the motion. Voice vote; all ayes. Motion carried.

#### AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION

None

Village Administrator Mary Jo Seehausen The Village will start using Positive Pay. The final training has taken place so we will have ACH Positive Pay and all payables will go through Positive Pay. The program is going to be a big help with payables. Also, I am working on project updates and hope to have that out to the Trustees soon. ComEd has pulled permits to move utility poles that have been holding up the Citgo Project, so hopefully that will move forward soon. Work on streetlights should start up in the Spring as communication is good and continues with ComEd.

**Director of Public Infrastructure Dave Toepper** No Report.

**Fire Chief Nowell Fillion** No Report, but handed out a letter to all board members regarding Fire Department needs that would be met through the upcoming Referendum to be discussed later in the meeting.

**Police Chief Kevin Shaughnessy** Offered comments in regards to the Police Reform Legislation the recently passed in Springfield. The Village will be affected as it speaks to regulating the conduct and performance of our officers in performing their duty. The legislation is nearly 700 pages, so it is still being reviewed. It includes a lot of requirements and restrictions. It will require the Village of Steger to have body cameras on all officers by January of 2025. There is no funding in this Bill to aid with this expense. Part of the Bill includes the saving and storing of the video produced by these body cameras. This is a very expensive process. Also, part of this bill is the elimination of Cash Bond. This will be a challenge moving forward. We are still learning how this will affect our ability to get arrestees to appear in court. There are many aspects of this Bill that still need to be deciphered. Mayor Peterson added that there are a lot of unfunded mandates included in this bill that will have an affect on our Village. Mayor Peterson urges everyone to reach out to our local legislators and let them know how we feel about the negative impact this stands to have on our Village. Trustee Buxton stated that he had reached out to Thaddeus Jones to express his concerns with the financial impact this will have on our Village. Chief Shaughnessy assured the board that in discussion with his officers, we have dedicated individuals that will come to work and continue to do their job to the best of their ability. They understand the ramifications of the legislation and desire to improve what they do.

**EMA Chief Tom Johnston** Added that there is also word of legislation coming down limiting police officer presence on school grounds that came to our attention today. In the Emergency Management world we cannot express how much that will be detrimental. They are the first line of defense for schools right now, and if you take that away you are leaving certain schools defenseless without having resource officers present.

**Village Attorney** We are reviewing the legislation that was passed. The bill is in excess of 600 pages. We will provide a memorandum to you at no cost to the Village. There will probably be further permutations to the bill as time goes on.

**Treasurer** Nothing tonight, but after I review the Financial Report that is coming, I will report at next meeting.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Trustee Joyce made a motion to approve ORDINANCE No. 1254: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 82, SECTION 82-486 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF STEGER, ILLINOIS REGARDING PARKING FOR THE VILLAGE OF STEGER, ILLINOIS. Trustee Lopez seconded the motion. Roll was called. The following Trustees voted aye; Joyce, Perchinski, Kozy, Lopez, Skrezyna and Buxton. Mayor Peterson voted aye. Motion carried.

#### Referendum Question:

Mayor Peterson started by stating that the purpose of this ordinance is to go to referendum to allow our residents to decide whether or not they would support an increase to our real estate taxes for the Village to provide \$600,000 in order to add personnel to our Fire Department. I will allow Fire Chief Fillion to explain the need.

Chief Fillion explained that currently during a 24-hour period we have one Paramedic and one EMT, both firefighter certified. It is becoming increasing difficult to answer all the calls that we run. This past year we ran over 1800 calls which seems to go up about 100 calls per year. It is getting harder to do that especially with the hospital being further away and the mutual aid calls that we are asked to assist with. The Chief explained that of the surrounding communities, Steger gets one of the highest amounts of calls. Other communities handling our volume of calls have two sets of personnel and some cases additional personnel. There are communities handling less calls than Steger with two sets of ambulance personnel. Volunteer assistance is getting harder and harder to find. This referendum would make it possible to add an additional Paramedic and EMT Firefighter around the clock which would allow us to operate two ambulances. This would aid in answering the calls here in the Village not to mention the mutual aid calls that we answer. Our goal is, if we get a second crew, to have one crew at the main Firehouse where it is now, and add the second to the Firehouse No. 2 behind the Police Station thus eliminating delays currently caused by trains, if the call is on the West side of town. We continue to search for grants to help with equipment that we have been very frugal with. Chief Fillion was very sincere in the need for this increase. He is available for any questions that should come up regarding this request. The funds being requested in addition to adding a second crew, would be able to raise the pay to a more livable wage. Trustee Lopez commended Chief Fillion and his Department for doing their part in controlling costs but also mentioned that we cannot sacrifice cost for safety when it comes to protecting our citizens.

Trustee Perchinski made a motion to approve Resolution No.1151: RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THE SUBMISSION TO THE ELECTORS OF THE VILLAGE OF STEGER A BINDING REFERENDUM QUESTION OF WHETHER TO INCREASE THE LIMITING RATE FOR THE LEVY 2021 FOR THE PURPOSES OF FUNDING THE HIRING AND COMPENSATION OF ADDITIONAL FIRE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL TO BE VOTED ON AT THE CONSOLIDATED ELECTION TO BE HELD ON APRIL 6, 2021 FOR THE VILLAGE OF STEGER, COUNTIES OF COOK AND WILL, STATE OF ILLINOIS. Trustee Joyce seconded the motion. Roll was called. The following Trustees voted aye; Joyce, Perchinski, Kozy, Lopez, Skrezyna and Buxton. Mayor Peterson voted aye. Motion carried.

Trustee Buxton made a motion to approve the engagement letter provided by BKD CPAs & Advisors. Trustee Lopez seconded the motion. Roll was called. The following Trustees voted aye; Joyce, Perchinski, Kozy, Lopez, Skrezyna and Buxton. Mayor Peterson voted aye. Motion carried.

Trustee Perchinski questioned a zoning issue in regards to a property on Cottage Grove and whether it could be expedited. The Village Attorney stated that it has to go before the Zoning Board which will happen before our next Village Board meeting and it can be ratified at that time.

## AN ORDINANCE APPROVING CERTAIN LAND USE RELIEF FOR THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 22914 WOODLAWN AVENUE, STEGER, ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, the Village of Steger, Counties of Cook and Will, State of Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, Jeff Narjes/Tech One Heating and Air (the "Applicant") submitted a request to the Village of Steger (the "Village") for land use relief for the property located at 22914 Woodlawn Avenue, Steger, Illinois (PINs: 32-35-302-064-0000 and 32-35-302-046-0000) (the "Subject Property") to allow a metal pole barn with an office maintained on the Subject Property to continue to be used for the operation of a heating and cooling service company (the "Proposed Use"); and

WHEREAS, the Village's Planning and Zoning Board of Appeals (the "PZBA") held a hearing, pursuant to proper notice, at which the Applicant provided testimony regarding the Proposed Use; and

WHEREAS, the PZBA considered granting the Applicant a special use permit in compliance with Section 10.3-6.6 of the "Comprehensive

Amendment to the Zoning Ordinance of the Village of Steger, Illinois," commonly referred to as the "Zoning Code," to allow for the Proposed Use (the "Land Use Relief"); and

WHEREAS, evidence was introduced at the aforesaid hearing establishing that: (a) the Proposed Use is consistent with existing uses in the general vicinity thereof; (b) the Subject Property is suitable for the Proposed Use; (c) the Land Use Relief will not negatively alter the essential character of the locality; (d) the Land Use Relief will not endanger the public safety; and (e) the Land Use Relief will not be detrimental to the public welfare or injurious to other property or improvements; and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the PZBA made certain findings of fact, which are set forth on the "Recommendation", attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A, and made a recommendation to approve the Land Use Relief; and

WHEREAS, in light of the foregoing, the Village President (the "President") and the Board of Trustees of the Village (the "Village Board" and with the President, the "Corporate Authorities") have determined that it is in the best interests of the Village to approve the Land Use Relief;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Steger, Counties of Cook and Will, and the State of Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are herein incorporated and made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2. Approval of Land Use Relief. The findings of fact and Recommendation of the PZBA are hereby adopted, and, in accordance with said findings of fact and Recommendation, the Village Board approves the Land Use Relief for the Subject Property.

Section 3. Savings Clause. This Ordinance shall not affect suits pending or rights existing at the time this Ordinance takes effect, but such suits and rights shall continue in force to the same extent and with like effect as if this Ordinance be taken, construed or held to avoid or impair any cause of action now existing under any ordinance of the Village, or any amendment thereto, but as to any consideration of action now existing, such ordinance and amendment thereto, shall be continued in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication as provided by law.

## VILLAGE OF STEGER (THE "VILLAGE") PLANNING & ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS RECOMMENDATION

RE: Special use permit application to allow a metal pole barn with an office maintained on a residential to continue to be used for the operation of a heating and cooling service company within the Village.

President and Board of Trustees:

The Planning & Zoning Board of Appeals ("PZBA") met on Wednesday, January 20, 2021 and discussed the petition of Jeff Narjes/Tech One Heating and Air (the "Applicant") for a special use permit in compliance with Section 10.3-6.6 of the "Comprehensive Amendment to the Zoning Ordinance of the Village of Steger, Illinois," commonly referred to as the "Zoning Code," related to allowing a metal pole barn with an office on a residential property to continue to be used for the operation of a heating and cooling service company on a residential property (the "Special Use Permit"). Proper notice of the Meeting was provided in accordance with Section 10.4.3 of the Zoning Ordinance.

During the public hearing, testimony and evidence were introduced establishing that the Applicant is the contract purchaser of a parcel of real estate within the Village, commonly known as 22914 Woodlawn Avenue, Steger, Illinois with Property Index Numbers 32-35-302-064-0000 and 32-35-302-046-0000 ("Subject Property"). At the hearing, Applicant presented to the PZBA a request for a Special Use Permit to allow a metal pole barn with an office maintained on the Subject Property to continue to be used for the operation of a heating and cooling service company ("Proposed Use"). Further, the Applicant provided credible evidence showing that: (a) the Proposed Use is consistent with existing uses in the general vicinity thereof; (b) the Subject Property is suitable for the Proposed Use; (c) the Special Use Permit will not negatively alter the essential character of the locality; (d) the Special Use Permit will not endanger the public safety; and (e) the Special Use Permit will not be detrimental to the public welfare or injurious to other property or improvements.

In light of the testimony introduced at the public hearing, the PZBA found that Proposed Use of the Subject property is in furtherance of the public interest and will not be detrimental to the health, safety, and welfare of the Village and its residents.

It is the recommendation of the PZBA to approve the special use permit application to allow for the continued use of a metal pole barn with an office for a service company (heating and cooling) on a residential property.
