MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF STEGER, WILL & COOK COUNTIES, ILLINOIS

The Board of Trustees convened in regular session at 7:00 P.M. on this 7th day of November, 2022 in the Municipal Building of the Village of Steger and via Teleconference that was made available to all residents. Mayor Peterson led all in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

The roll was called. The following Trustees were present; Thurmond, Lopez, Stewart, Trotier, Joyce and Perchinski. Mayor Peterson was present.

Also present: Village Administrator Mary Jo Seehausen, Director of Public Infrastructure Dave Toepper, Fire Chief Michael Long, Police Chief Greg Smith, EMA Chief Tom Johnston and Community Center Director Diana Rossi.

MINUTES

Trustee Joyce made a motion to approve the minutes of the October 17th meeting as all members have copies. Trustee Perchinski seconded the motion. Voice vote; all ayes. Motion carried.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION

Trustee Thurmond introduced Juan Hernandez of Alicia's House and made a presentation on behalf of the Charity Softball event that took place at the same time as Steger Day of Music in August. Trustee Thurmond gave special thanks to all participants including Tim Glass and Jim Hanus for their donations for the event, the teams: The Police Department, The Fire Department, Spartan Baseball and King Steger. The softball game raised \$708.00 and I am honored to present this to Alicia's House. Juan Hernandez accepted the donation with gratitude and gave an overview of Alicia's House that his family started in 2001 and named for his granddaughter who was killed when she was four years old. Alicia's House feeds over 30,000 individuals annually in this area. They are gearing up for the holidays which is a very busy time for them. Alicia's House helps the Village of Steger every year with holiday food baskets that are distributed to families that need help at the holidays.

Mayor Peterson thanked Mr. Hernandez also, for all that Alicia's House does for the Village. The help from Alicia's House is in conjunction with other donations and the food collection that takes place during the Santa Parade through the whole town that will take place the Saturday after Thanksgiving. Canned goods can be left at the curb on Saturday November 26th and will be collected during the Santa Parade. Items can also be dropped off at Village Hall. Alicia's House also partners with the Village on other events such as Shop with a Cop.

Trustee Perchinski reminded everyone about Shop with a Cop that works a little different in Steger. Mr. Hernandez developed the idea where 2nd and 3rd grade children write letters to Santa Claus on who they want to make Christmas special for, why they want to make it special and what they want to get them.

REPORTS

Village Administrator Mary Jo Seehausen We are continuing to work on our budget reports for 2023, almost all departments have turned them in. They have been sent over to finance. I have given all trustees a copy of the tentative tax levy that will be available to be viewed here in the clerk's office. We will be passing our tax levy at the first meeting in December.

Director of Public Infrastructure Dave Toepper Hydrant flushing is done for the season, we start back up in the Spring. Just been out cleaning up a lot of storm damage from Saturday and getting ready for the Winter Season.

Fire Chief Michael Long We finished up our coloring contest last week. Gave three lucky kids a ride to school in the Fire Engine. Winning drawings are on display in Village Hall. The Fire Department has raffle tickets available for their drawing to be held on November 27th at their Pancake Breakfast.

Police Chief Greg Smith Just finished up the Pizza War with the Fire Department. The two departments will meet at Bambino's to celebrate the contest of which both were winners. November 15th Kim Fox will be hosting an event at Prairie State College. It is community-based conversation with Kim Fox from 6-7 pm.

EMA Chief Tom Johnston We had branch clean up from the recent wind storm and some power lines down that we helped with traffic control. Waiting for more particulars on a vehicle that Monee EMA has that they are willing to donate to Steger EMA.

Community Center Director Diana Rossi For our Halloween Party we had 260 kids and 50 parents. We had a full house; everyone had a great time and hopefully it will help build use of the facility. There were over 1100 people through the community center over the past two weeks and turnout was very good for early voting.

Trustee Perchinski made a motion to accept the mayor's appointment of Dave Mendez to President of the Steger Recreation Board. Trustee Lopez seconded the motion. Roll was called. The following Trustees voted aye; Thurmond, Lopez, Stewart, Trotier, Joyce and Perchinski. Mayor Peterson voted aye. Motion carried.

Village Clerk Zagone gave Dave Mendez the Oath of Office installing him as President of the Steger Recreation Board.

VILLAGE CLERK Clerk Zagone read a thank you note from family of Luanne Thurmond. Additionally, Clerk Zagone read from an invite to a public meeting to be held in Sauk Village in regards to the Sauk Village Multi-Use Path Project that the Village of Steger is interested in connecting to in the future. The date of the meeting is November 15, 2022 from 5-7 pm at the Sauk Village Municipal Center at 21801 Torrence Ave.

TRUSTEES REPORTS

Trustee Joyce November 30th will be the last day of yard waste collection in the village. We still have one street sweeping left for the year, both of these items will be posted on the Village website. This Wednesday I will be going with Dave Toepper to the Cook County Government Surplus. They are doing property donation of heavy equipment to municipalities within Cook County. We are going to go see if there is anything that could be put to use in Steger. November 27, Caroline Pfeiffer will turn 100 years old. She was a long-time member of the Steger Fire Department Auxiliary and her husband was the Deputy Chief for many years. Cards can be sent to her at Beecher Manor room 25.

Trustee Trotier Just working on grants. We have had a couple productive conversations.

Trustee Thurmond I want to comment on what a great turn out there was for the St. Liborius Trunk or Treat event. There were 36 trunks and over 700 attendees. I just want to say what a great event it was.

Trustee Stewart I want to thank Dave Mendez for stepping in to my old role. I appreciate it and want to let you know that I am here to support you. Also, I want to congratulate the Steger Storm Football Program. They hosted the Super Bowl this past weekend and it was a great success. The turnout was great. Congratulations to all the young men and their coaches and staff. Sign-ups for basketball and volleyball are still ongoing. Currently we have 51 in basketball program. I had a meeting with Chicago Heights and they have 15 kids who want to join us in Steger to help make our program bigger and better.

Trustee Perchinski Just want to remind everyone to get out and vote tomorrow.

<u>BILLS</u>

Trustee Joyce made a motion to pay all bills as listed when funds become available. Trustee Lopez seconded the motion.

Discussion: Trustee Joyce questioned two identical amount bills from M&J Underground. Administrator Seehausen confirmed that they were two separate main breaks with the same amount.

Roll was called. The following Trustees voted aye; Thurmond, Lopez, Stewart, Trotier, Joyce and Perchinski. Mayor Peterson voted aye. Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Emily Moharam introduced herself and described the Vape Shop they want to open in a space previously occupied by another Vape Shop that relocated nearby. Trustee Perchinski stated that from my perspective, I don't think our constituents want another Vape Shop in town.

Trustee Perchinski made a motion to deny the new business license application for Emily Moharam of Poisoned Apple Smokes LLC at 3412 Chicago Road. Trustee Stewart seconded the motion. Roll was called. The following Trustees voted aye; Thurmond, Stewart, Trotier, Joyce and Perchinski. Mayor Peterson voted aye. Trustee Lopez abstained. Motion carried.

Trustee Perchinski made a motion to deny the new business license application for Truth Hookah & Cigars at 3345 Chicago Road. Trustee Thurmond seconded the motion. Roll was called. The following Trustees voted aye; Thurmond, Lopez, Stewart, Trotier, Joyce and Perchinski. Mayor Peterson voted aye. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

Village Administrator Seehausen explained the Amendment to Standard of Terms between DACRA Tech company and the Village of Steger. This program is currently used by our Police Department for AO and Parking Citations. We also use it for when we start writing our housing violations. Currently we are in contract with them and we pay them a percentage of what is collected. For the past 5 years we have averaged payments to DACRA of \$14,883.00 per year (1240.25 per month) by percentages. The difference is they are going to flat rate instead of percentages. This means no matter how many tickets we collect, the payment is the same. DACRA is switching all their clients from percentage to standardized billing. Trustee Perchinski asked why it jumped so much in 2024? Administrator Seehausen explained that we have been with this company since 1997. We have paid the same rate which has included all program updates. There is basically no increase for 2023 and the first increase is not felt until 2024. Trustee Thurmond stated he is not in favor of the 20% increase. I would rather see if we can go 4.5% for the three years, it still gives them an increase. Administrator Seehausen replied, we do know that the CPI is 9.91% this year.

Trustee Joyce made a motion to approve the Amendment to Standard of Terms between DACRA Tech company and the Village of Steger. Trustee Perchinski seconded the motion.

Discussion:

Trustee Trotier asked if this is to increase it by 20%? Mayor Peterson stated no: This is to change our billing from percentage to flat rate. The flat fee in 2023 would be \$1250.00 per month. In 2024 it would be \$1500.00 and 1567.50 in 2025. There would be no increase for 2023 and then a jump for 2024-25. If we deny it, effectively what will happen is they will come back and put an increase in for next year. The rule of thumb is to push increases off as long as we can. If you don't want the 20% increase in 2024, we can go back to them and increase it in 2023 and then it is a smaller increase in 2024. We could do it over three years, or do what is beneficial to us and not get an increase next year and then take the increase over 2024-25 when CPI has gone up 9.9%. Trustee Trotier confirmed that it would be no increase in 2023 if passed.

Roll was called. The following Trustees voted aye; Joyce and Perchinski. The following Trustees voted no; Thurmond, Lopez and Trotier. Mayor Peterson did not vote (Mayor's vote only counts to break a tie). Trustee Stewart abstained. Motion was denied.

This Amendment #1 (the "Amendment #1") is dated <u>November 11, 2022</u>, by and among <u>Village of Steger</u> ("Village of Steger"), and <u>Municipal Systems LLC</u>, a DACRA Tech company ("Municipal Systems") shall be effective on January 1, 2023 (the "Amendment #1 Effective Date").

Whereas Village of Steger is a party to the Standard Terms and Conditions agreement dated July 17, 2002, covering the Administrative Building Code System and the Municipal Ordinance Violation Enforcement System, as amended by the Amendment to Agreement dated July 7, 2014 (the "ABC MOVE Agreement");

Whereas Village of Steger is a party to the Standard Terms and Conditions - Administrative Parking and Compliance Heareing System agreement dated February 3, 1997, as amended by the Addendum to Standard Terms and Conditions (Administrative Parking and Compliance Hearing System) dated March 31, 2008 (the "MOS Agreement");

Whereas Village of Steger is a party to the Software License and Support Agreement covering the Implementation of TAG (Municipal Stickers, Parking Permits, and Animal Tags) dated November 1, 2010 (the "TAG Agreement");

Whereas the ABC MOVE Agreement, MOS Agreement and the TAG Agreement were assigned to Municipal Systems LLC, as notified by the Notice of Assignment dated January 25, 2021. The ABC MOVE Agreement, MOS Agreement and the TAG Agreement, as assigned, shall hereinafter be referred to as the "Original Agreements;"

Whereas the parties have agreed to amend and extend certain terms and conditions of the Original Agreements as follows:

- 1. Incorporation of Recitals: The foregoing recitals are herein incorporated herein in this paragraph as if set forth herein in their entirety.
- The term, as outlined in each of the respective Original Agreements shall be modified as follows:

The Initial Term of this Agreement shall terminate on December 31, 2022 (the "Initial Term"). After the Initial Term, the Agreement shall be extended to December 31, 2025 (the "Extended Term"). After the Extended Term, this Agreement shall automatically renew in successive

periods of one (1) year each, beginning on January 1 of each year, unless either party serves written notice to the other a minimum of 90 days prior to the end of the relevant term then in effect. During each renewal period, all terms and conditions in this Agreement shall continue unchanged except that the Monthly Amount (the "Monthly Service Fee") shall increase 4.5% for each renewal period. (The Initial Term, Extended Term and any successive renewal terms shall collectively be referred to as the "Term").

3. The license fees as outlined in each of the respective Original Agreements shall be modified to provide for the following:

Village of Steger shall pay a fee to Municipal Systems for all service contained in the Original Agreements as follows (the "Monthly Service Fee"):

January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2025	\$1,567.50 per month

5. Except as set forth in this Amendment #1, the Original Agreements remain unaffected and shall continue in full force and effect in accordance with its terms. If there is conflict between this Amendment #1 and the Original Agreements, the terms of this Amendment #1 shall prevail.

6. Other Agreements:

a. Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the Collection Services Agreement dated January 15, 2015 between Village of Steger and Municipal Collections Services Inc, as amended by that certain Amendment to Collection Services Agreement dated February 22, 2018, as assigned to Municipal Collections Services LLC, per the Notice of Assignment letter dated June 2, 2021 (the "Collections Agreement") shall remain in full-force and shall not be modified by this Agreement.

7. This Amendment #1 may be executed in two or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original, and each of which together shall constitute a single instrument. This Amendment #1 may be executed, signed, and transmitted by a party using electronic means, including but not limited to PDF, and may be transmitted electronically and shall be deemed for all purposes as containing the original signature of the transmitting party and legally binding upon such transmitting party.

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND CONSENTING TO AN APPLICATION BY OAK RIDGE DEVELOPMENT, LLC FOR A CLASS 8 DESIGNATION PURSUANT TO THE COOK COUNTY REAL PROPERTY ASSESSMENT CLASSIFICATION ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED, FOR CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF STEGER, COUNTIES OF COOK AND WILL, STATE OF ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village of Steger, Counties of Cook and Will, State of Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Cook County Real Property Assessment Classification Ordinance (the "Classification Ordinance") provides a system for classifying real property located in Cook County, Illinois for real estate tax assessment purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Classification Ordinance established property tax classifications to encourage industrial and commercial development in Cook County, which will increase employment opportunities and increase the real estate tax base in Cook County; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Village's Board of Trustees (collectively, the "Corporate Authorities") desire to promote industrial and commercial development within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Classification Ordinance allows for an assessment classification known as a Class 8 (the "Class 8 Designation") for real estate that is used primarily for industrial and commercial purposes, is considered abandoned or is substantially rehabilitated and that is located within certain designated areas; and

WHEREAS, a Class 8 Designation is also conditioned upon certain findings and approvals of the municipality governing said real estate; and

WHEREAS, a Class 8 Designation results in a substantial reduction of the real estate taxes levied against such commercial or industrial property by reducing the assessment level for the real estate; and

WHEREAS, there exists certain real estate located in the Village commonly known as 3045 Holeman Avenue, Steger, Illinois, with the following property index numbers: 32-33-400-021-0000, 32-33-400-022-0000, and 32-33-400-023-0000 (the "Subject Property"); and

WHEREAS, Oak Ridge Development, LLC (the "Applicant") is the contract purchaser and future occupant of the Subject Property; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant seeks a Class 8 Designation for the Subject Property; and

WHEREAS, the Subject Property is located in Bloom Township, is currently vacant and is eligible for Class 8 Designation; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant has proven to the Village that the real estate tax incentive that would be provided by a Class 8 Designation is necessary to successfully redevelop the Subject Property; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant has submitted an Economic Disclosure Statement to the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have hereby determined that a Class 8 Designation is necessary for the redevelopment of the Subject Property to occur, and the commercial use of the Subject Property is, or will be, necessary and beneficial to the Village's economy; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have further determined that "special circumstances" exist to justify waiving the twelve (12) month vacancy requirement, as "but for" a Class 8 Designation, the purchase, rehabilitation, and re-occupancy of the Subject Property is not economically viable; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined that approving a Class 8 Designation for the Subject Property is in the best interests of the Village because it will, among other things, further the growth of the Village, increase the real estate tax base of the Village, provide employment opportunities within the Village, increase the economic activity within the Village and eliminate blight within the Village; and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the Corporate Authorities hereby approve, support and consent to an application for a Class 8 Designation for the Subject Property being submitted to and approved by the Cook County Assessor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Steger, Counties of Cook and Will and State of Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the statements set forth in the preamble to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: The Corporate Authorities recognize that the incentive benefits provided by the Class 8 Designation are necessary to carry out the redevelopment of the Subject Property. The Corporate Authorities hereby support, approve and consent to a Class 8 Designation for the Subject Property. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute, and the Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest to, countersign and affix the Seal of the Village to any and all such documentation as may be necessary to carry out and effectuate the purpose of this Ordinance. The officers, employees and/or agents of the Village, shall take all action necessary or reasonably required to carry out, give effect to and effectuate the intent of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: The headings of the sections, paragraphs and subparagraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for the convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Ordinance, nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provision of this Ordinance. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any part of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or determined to conflict with any law, statute, or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, that portion shall be stricken from this Ordinance and the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall continue in full force and effect to the fullest extent possible.

SECTION 4: All prior actions of the Village's officials, employees and agents with respect to the subject matter of this Ordinance are hereby expressly ratified.

SECTION 5: All ordinances, resolutions, rules and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall be immediately in full force and effect after passage, approval and publication. A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.
