MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF STEGER, WILL & COOK COUNTIES, ILLINOIS

The Board of Trustees convened in regular session at 7:00 P.M. on this 2nd day of October, 2023 in the Municipal Building of the Village of Steger, Illinois. Mayor Peterson led all in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

The roll was called. The following Trustees were present; Thurmond, Stewart, Trotier and Joyce. Mayor Peterson was present. Trustees Lopez and Perchinski were absent.

Also present: Village Administrator Mary Jo Seehausen, Fire Chief Mike Long, Police Chief Greg Smith, Community Center Director Diana Rossi, EMA Chief Tom Johnston and Village Attorney James Vasselli. Director of Public Infrastructure Dave Toepper was absent.

AWARDS, HONORS AND SPECIAL RECOGNITION

MINUTES

Trustee Joyce made a motion to approve the minutes of the September 18th meeting as all members have copies. Trustee Thurmond seconded the motion. Voice vote; all ayes. Motion carried.

AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION

Brenda Thunherst of 22720 Cottage Grove Ave. came before the board first to thank the Steger Police Department for their handling of issues with her phones and the 911 call center. Problems with her phones caused unnecessary calls to 911 bringing officers to her home on multiple occassions. The issue has been fixed through her phone provider. Her second issue deals with a fence installed by her neighbor on the property line that appears to go against the Steger fence ordinance. Ms. Thunherst described the issues she believes go against ordinance, and the frustration she met getting response from Village Hall. Mayor Peterson stated that he was made aware of the issue today. This issue is going to be sent to the Zoning and Planning Board to review. A public hearing will be held at a future date when Ms. Thunherst will be invited to express her views and show the board any pictures to aid in their recommendation to the Village Board. The Village Board will take official action based on the recommendation of the Zoning and Planning Board. As soon as there is a date for the meeting of the Zoning and Planning Board, Ms. Thunherst will be informed. Ms. Thunherst thanked Mayor Peterson for this information, but reiterated her frustration with the disregard she felt in communication

with Village Hall. Mayor Peterson stated that he and Village Administrator Seehausen will address her concerns.

Julie Stone came before the board with questions regarding the Village's plans for dealing with flood issues. Ms. Stone stated that the board had voted to work on the flood project and is wondering what the hold up is, and when it might begin. Village Administrator Seehausen stated that the plan is to start in the spring. The attempt is to work on flood issues at the same time as replacing lead water lines. This will also coincide with repaving of roads. Bringing all three projects together will only require tearing up the roads once. Village Administrator Seehausen stated that we will be starting on Will County through 32nd Street, that is component two of the drainage project which was the first one voted to start. The project will go out for bid and a start date will be set up at that time.

REPORTS

Village Administrator Mary Jo Seehausen I want to start talking about Octoberfest, I thought it was a really great day. I want to thank Diane and her employees for all that they did for the kids activities that was enjoyed by all. Obviously, Public Works did a great job and I want to thank them for that. Chief Johnson was there to make sure all went well along with Chief Smith and the Fire Department. Kiwanis had a great day for their Chile Cook-Off. The weather was great and 60 people enjoyed the tasting. The next thing is we are going to have our Halloween Home Decorating. Flyers will be posted and entrants will have until October 25th to enter. The winners will be announced at the first Village Board Meeting in November.

I want to talk about DACRA which is on the agenda tonight. DACRA was approved for a three year contract the end of last year. The Village is looking to switch to DACRA's software, the terms of the contract previously approved does not change. The only change is that we are migrating to their software.

I attended the Rec Board meeting last Tuesday. We have a brand-new board and they are moving in a very good direction. I am trying to assist them as much as I can with just how their meetings are to be held. They are working very hard to get their individual programs going in a good direction. Tony from softball really wanted to commend Mr. Marino. There is another field that he helped dig out and get in good condition. Steger Storm opened the concession stand during Octoberfest and offered desserts. Regarding the Water Tower project: Like I reported last board meeting, we had a pre-bid meeting. Questions are open to these bidders until October 10th. Bids will be opened on the 24th. We had a good turnout, so I think people have a better understanding of the project. The Village Welcome Signs are still being worked on. We needed to find a better layout for them so that we are not replacing an entire sign when changes are needed. I am still working with them on that and adding two additional event panels.

Director of Public Infrastructure Dave Toepper Trustee Stewart reported he had talked with Dave in regards to the construction that is taking place on Cottage Grove. They are building a house over there and muddy conditions have resulted in mud on the

roadway. They are working to help keep that cleaned up. The road project in town should be starting up again this week.

Trustee Trotier:

I attended the Village of Steger Parks & Recreation Board meeting at the Louis Sherman Community Center on Sept. 26th.

Mary Jo Seehausen guided the new board on how to run an official board meeting using Roberts Rules of Order.

Dave Mendez and his board members shared that all the teams have improved immensely. The emphasis was on how our programs offer more for less money compared to other towns.

It was nice to see such an active positive group in the community who is striving to share and grow various sports in Steger to enrich our kids.

I've shared a few grants that may be a good fit for our town. Mary Jo Seehausen is looking into them. The grants consist of additional money for the Critter Park/Susan Lane area (retention pond) and COVID money that can possibly be applied for ELKAY water dispensers.

The Steger-South Chicago Heights Library is hosting a fundraiser concert on Nov. 4th at the VFW located at 3332 Chicago Rd. and will feature a very entertaining live band. Tickets are \$20 each. Contact the library at 708-755-5040 for more information or stop by 54 E 31st St., Steger, IL. The benefit is to raise funds for a new marque sign.

Mayor Peterson added that there is a flyer for the Library event on the table along with a fly regarding the Recycling Event hosted by State Representative Anthony DeLuca to be held on October 18th from 11 am -1 pm in the Village Green Parking Lot. This event will be for electrical products, shredding and medical.

Trustee Thurmond:

I attended the IML conference in Chicago over the past weekend and met with various municipal trustees, mayors, superintendents, and others. Some take aways were, The conference was a great way to refresh our municipal obligations as elected officials. Also, the conference was a great way to get together with other elected officials and discuss common goals and challenges.

The conference, through speaking to others, helped redirect some of my thought processes towards helping better serve our community.

At the conference I had the pleasure of meeting our Robinson Engineering lead engineer on the lead line project, Diane Moeller. We had a great conversation.

The highlights of the discussion were that polling of the towns equal to ours and currently providing the same service for, we are right in line with up-to-date information and expectations.

Diane also stated the Robinson Engineering has acquired more grant funding for the project. We closed our discussion with my invitation to come to a future board meeting to give a presentation of the project's progress.

I met with the Third Millennium Associates who specialize in end-to-end software billing solutions, utility bill printing, mail outsourcing, vehicle stickers, pet license, renewals, and online payment solutions. They have been in business helping local governments serve their citizens for over 22 years and would like to come to a future board meeting to give a presentation.

I recertified for OMA (open meetings act) while attending one of the convention sessions. I met Chad Johnson from USG Water Solutions who provide maintenance services to municipal water infrastructure and claim to be the leading provider of asset management. Chad has expressed his desire to help Steger come up with compressive and real goal-oriented programs for maintaining our water towers. He would also like to come and discuss their company's operation and what they can do for Steger. Mrs. Whisenant sends a big thank you to the publics works department for patching some holes in the front of her house on Dorsetshire.

I'd like to give recognition to Barb Dorman, Southland voice nonprofit free food pop up and her volunteers who distributes food to over 2000 people every week at 3 local locations.

Mayor Peterson asked if the grant funds mentioned were new funds. Village Administrator Seehausen stated, those mentioned are the two grants we already have and that we have applied for a third. The funds are being used currently to map the lines that need to be replaced.
