Police Blotter

- 2/3 Theft – 22331 Cottage Grove Ave. Offender(s) unknown stole the catalytic converter from the victim's 2022 Mitsubishi Outlander.
- 2/3 Juvenile Crisis Intervention – 94 W. Richton Rd. DCFS responded to the Police Department and placed the juvenile back with parent.
- 2/4 Battery – 94 W. Richton Rd. A physical altercation ensued between two parents at a school basketball game.
- 2/4 Traffic Arrest – 34th & Lewis St. Lashon M. Brown Jr. 28, of Crete was arrested for DWLS. Brown was processed, bonded, and given a ride home.
- 2/5 Domestic Disturbance – 3400 Block of S. Kings Rd. Parties separated, report on file.
- 2/5 Disturbance – 3327 Chicago Rd. (Glass Tap). Report of physical altercation between patrons. No complaints to be signed, refusal.
- 2/5 DUI, UUW – 3500 Block of Edward Dr. Anthony Brown, 48, of Crete was arrested for DUI and Unlawful Use or Possession of Weapon by Felon. Brown was processed and transported to the Will County Adult Detention Facility.
- 2/5 Battery – 22331 Cottage Grove Ave. Student reported receiving a battery from two other juveniles. Police are investigating.
- 2/6 Criminal Trespass – 100 W. Richton Rd. Juveniles were climbing on the roof of the building. Local Ordinance violation, juveniles released to parents.

- 2/6 Manufacturer, Deliver Possession of Cannabis, DWLS – Chicago & 35th St. Lacey A. Reid, 27, of Sauk Village was stopped for a traffic infraction. Police discovered that Reid's driver's license was suspended. During the search of the vehicle, approximately 272 grams of cannabis was located. Reid was arrested, processed, and transported to the Will County Adult Detention Facility.
- 2/6 Domestic Battery, CDP – 300 Block of W. 34th St. Ronald T. Doss, 45, of Chicago was arrested for Domestic Battery, Criminal Damage to Property, and Interfering with the Reporting of Domestic Violence. Doss was processed and transported to the Will County Adult Detention Facility.
- 2/7 Retail Theft – 3009 Chicago Rd. (Dollar General). A M/B Subject, approximately 5'9" wearing gray sweatpants, dark hoodie, black varsity style jacket with white rings around the collar stole energy drinks valued at \$40.00.
- 2/7 Missing Juvenile – 3400 Block of S. Kings Rd. A 3yr. old juvenile was found wandering near businesses of 34th & Kings Rd. A tenant of the Linden Park Apartments contacted the police. The child was returned to the juvenile's parent. DCFS contacted for follow-up.
- 2/7 Fraud – 3507 Chicago Rd. (Shell Gas Station). The victim, told police he withdrew \$200.00 U.S.C. from the Atm. When he returned home, he discovered three unauthorized transactions from his account.
- 2/7 Traffic Arrest, Crash – Resulting from a traffic crash investigation, Luis D. Martinez, 23, of Steger was arrested for No Valid Driver's License. Martinez was processed and bonded.
- 2/8 Crisis Intervention Juvenile – 0-100 Block of 32nd St. A juvenile student walked out of Bloom Trail H.S. Police located the juvenile and released her to a parent.
- 2/8 Disturbance – 3500 Block of John St. Verbal altercation between two acquaintances escalated and a physical altercation ensued. Parties separated, prosecution declined.
- 2/8 Endangering the life of a Child – 3400 Block of Hopkins Ave. Anjanette D. Matthews, 27, of Steger was charged with two counts of child endangerment. DCFS was summoned to the Steger Police Department and took protective custody of the children. Matthews was processed and bonded.

- 2/8 Theft – 94 W. Richton Rd. (Columbia Central School) A student told police someone stole his Jordan gym shoes, valued at \$200.00 from his locker. The police and school staff are looking into the matter.
- 2/8 Criminal Damage to Property – 94 W. Richton Rd. Victim reported offender unknown damaged the rear window wiper on her 2008 GMC SUV. Police are investigating.
- 2/8 Disturbance – 34 W. 34th St. (American Legion). An intoxicated patron was involved in a verbal dispute with spouse, parties separated. The patron was requested to leave by staff. Police arrival, noted extreme intoxication. Paramedics were summoned and transported subject to St. James Olympia Field Hospital, due to level of intoxication.
- 2/9 Armed Robbery – 3440 Union Ave. (Vape Lords). Offender, described as male, wearing a blue hoodie, blue jeans, demanded money and merchandise from a store employee (weapon inferred). There were no injuries resulting from this incident. Through investigations, Austin J. Tribble, 29, of the 1300 Block of East St., Crete was arrested and charged with Aggravated Robber and Resisting a Peace officer. In addition, Tribble will be held on a Department of Corrections Parole Violation Warrant. Tribble was processed and transported to the Will County Adult Detention Facility.
- 2/9 Domestic Disturbance – 0-100 Block of W. 37th St. Verbal altercation, peace restored.
- 2/9 Criminal Damage to Property – 3000 Block of Wallace. Offender(s) unknown damaged the windshield of the victim's 2010 Honda Civic. The victim told police she did not hear any noises or observe any suspicious activity prior to the incident. Police are investigating.
