### **Police Blotter**

- 3/4 Domestic Dispute – 400 Block of W. 35<sup>th</sup> St. Verbal altercation, parties separated.
- 3/4 Domestic Disturbance – Verbal altercation, parties separated, peace restored.
- 3/5 Domestic Dispute – 3100 Block of Green St. Verbal altercation, parties separated upon police arrival.
- 3/6 Domestic Disturbance – 400 Block of W. 34<sup>th</sup> St. Physical altercation between siblings. Mutual combatants, peace restored.
- 3/6 Theft – 3600 Block of Union Ave. Offender(s) unknown stole a license plate from the victim's 2005 Chrysler. Report on file.
- 3/6 Warrant Arrest – 3400 Block of Union Ave. Police officers were notified by FLOCK Safety of a vehicle that had warrant information attached to the registration. Police made contact with the motorist Jerome A Millian, 44, of University Park as he exited Brick Oven Pizza. Officers confirmed the out-of-state Indiana warrant and placed Millian under arrest. Millian was processed and transported to the Will County Adult Detention Facility, where he awaits an extradition hearing.
- 3/6 Aggravated Fleeing & Eluding – 33<sup>rd</sup> & Chicago Rd. Police conducted a traffic stop on a gray, 2023 Kia Forte. As the officer made contact with the driver, the motorist drove away at a high rate of speed. Police attempted to stop the vehicle, but met with negative results. Police are investigating, charges pending.
- 3/7 Domestic Battery – 3700 Block of Union Ave. The victim reported being involved in a verbal altercation with his 29 year old son. The altercation escalated and became physical. The victim reported being struck in the face by his son multiple times. An ambulance was summoned to the scene to render medical treatment. The offender fled the scene prior to police arrival. Charges pending.

- 3/7 Criminal Damage to Property – 3000 Block of Union Ave. Complainant told police he discovered damage to the exterior door frame and found property inside the residence that did not belong to him. Report on file.
- 3/7 State Benefits Fraud – 3500 Block of Wallace Ave. Complainant advised offender unknown gained access to his Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT) card and made unauthorized transactions. Report on file.
- 3/8 Battery – 94 W. Richton Rd. (Columbia Central Middle School) Parents reported their 11 year old son was battered by one of the teachers. School staff told police a substitute teacher grabbed a student by the hoodie and pushed him back into the classroom. The minor sustained minor bruising. Steger Fire Department checked the minor's injuries and released him to his parents. School staff & police are investigating.

The subject was transported to St. James Hospital for a psych evaluation.
