- 6/10 Domestic Disturbance – 100 Block of W. 34<sup>th</sup> St. Verbal altercation between siblings. The sister was attempting to stop her intoxicated brother from driving. Upon police arrival the subject surrendered his keys to his sister. Peace restored.
- 6/10 Domestic Dispute – 0-100 Block of E. 31<sup>st</sup> St. The mother applied parental discipline after her son utilized profanity towards her. Report on file, peace restored.
- 6/11 Burglary to Motor Vehicle – 3200 Block of Florence Ave. Offender unknown entered the victim's unsecured 2009 BMW and removed approximately \$9.00 in change. TOT Investigations.
- 6/11 Burglary to Motor Vehicle – 3400 Block of Wallace Ave. Offender unknown gained access to the victim's 2016 Ford Fusion and removed change and a debit card. There were no signs of forced entry. TOT Investigations.

Police conducted a search but met with negative results. The subject was later found nearby at a relative's house. The offender was transported to St. James Olympia Fields Hospital for a psychiatric evaluation. Charges pending.
