- 5/20 Traffic Arrest – 34th & Ashland. Ayana M. Davis, 35, of University Park was arrested for No Valid Driver’s License. Davis was processed and bonded.
- 5/20 Unwanted Subject, Criminal Trespass – 3329 Chicago Rd. (Glass Tap). Staff found Clarence Kirk Bradley, 26, of Steger hiding in the kitchen during closing. Bradley claimed he was looking for his driver’s license. He told police, that staff inadvertently kept it. Bradley was escorted from the property and advised if he returns, he will be arrested for trespass.
- 5/20 Disturbance –Criminal Trespass– 3329 Chicago Rd. (Glass Tap). Staff told police three females were arguing with the bartender and one of the subject’s was trying to start a fight. The three subjects were banned from returning to the business.
