- 9/9 Burglary to motor Vehicle – 3400 Block of Green St. Offender unknown entered the victim’s unsecured 2002 GMC Yukon and removed loose change and an insurance card placement sleeve .
- 9/9 Domestic Dispute – 3400 Block of S. Kings Rd. Altercation between victim and ex-girlfriend. Information provided for an Order of Protection. Parties separated, peace restored.
- 9/9 Retail Theft – 3507 Chicago Road (Shell Gas Station). Offender removed two bundles of firewood without making payment. Police located offender who told police she thought her passenger paid for the firewood. Offender returned to the store to make restitution.
