- 10/14 Criminal Damage to property – 300 Block of 34th St. Offender(s) unknown broke the passenger side window on the victim's Dodge Challenger. TOT Investigations.
- 10/14 Criminal Damage to Property – 3400 Block of S. Kings Rd. Offender(s) unknown broke the rear driver side window on the victim's Dodge Challenger. TOT Investigations.
- 10/14 Burglary to Motor Vehicle – 300 Block of W. 35th St. Offender(s) unknown gained access to the victim's Nissan Altima by breaking the rear driver side window and removing the victim's personal property.
- 10/15 Criminal Damage to Property – 300 Block of W. 35th St. The victim told police he discovered a bullet hole in his driver side door of his 2013 Ford Explorer. During the preliminary investigation, police reviewed footage from the surveillance system but met with negative results. The victim stated he drove the vehicle yesterday to the local Dollar General and University Park. TOT Investigations.
- 10/15 Criminal Damage to Property – 71 W. 35th St. Offender unknown knocked over a statue on the south side of the church.
- 10/15 Theft – 300 Block of W. 34th St. Victim reported a package that was delivered by Amazon was stolen. Police reviewed camera footage of the incident and identified one of the juvenile offenders. The victim declined prosecution. TOT the juvenile's parent.
- 10/15 Curfew Violation – 3400 Union Ave. Police discovered two fifteen year old juveniles in violation of curfew. The juveniles were issued Local Ordinance Citations, and released to their parents.
