- 9/23 Disturbance – 3700 Block of Union Ave. Altercation between neighbors. Peace restored, report on file,
- 9/23 Domestic Disturbance – 400 Block of W. 34th St. Verbal altercation between cohabitants. Parties separated, peace restored.
- 9/23 Domestic Disturbance – 3500 Block of Ashland - Altercation regarding damaged property. Police are investigating.
- 9/24 Domestic Trouble Crisis Intervention – 3400 Block of Halsted Blvd. Victim reported her ex-boyfriend was at her residence banging on the door. The subject was previously trespassed from location. TOT Adjudication.
- 9/24 Domestic Disturbance – 400 Block of W. 35th St. Altercation between two siblings. Subjects were involved in a verbal altercation resulting in the reporting party kicking her sister out of the apartment. The sister reported being battered but there was no evidence substantiating her complaint. Parties separated, peace restored.
