- 11/4 Trespassing – 3507 Chicago Rd. (Shell Gas Station). Two subjects were engaged in a verbal altercation with store employee. The employee refused to sell cigarettes to the subject who was unable to produce identification. Both subjects were cited for Disorderly Conduct and Trespassed from the business.
- 11/4 Criminal Damage to Property - 400 Block of W. 34th St. Police were called for a group of juveniles fighting. One of the juveniles damaged a door leading to a storage area. The juvenile was trespassed from the apartment complex and released to a parent. TOT Juvenile Investigations.
- 11/4 Retail Theft -20 E. 34th St. (Party Liquors). Kim Biggs, 57 of Chicago stole two bottles of beer. Store staff declined prosecution. Biggs was trespassed from the business.
- 11/4 Unwanted Subject – 3327 Chicago Rd. (Glass Tap). Staff told police a subject came into the bar intoxicated and they wanted him out of the bar. Subject transported to St. James Hospital in Olympia Fields due to high level of intoxication.
- 11/5 Traffic Arrest- 34th & Chicago Rd. Khodee I. Brown, 25 of University Park was arrested for Driving While License Suspended. Brown was cited and released.
- 11/6 Domestic Dispute – 100 Block of W, Richton Rd. Verbal altercation, parties separated, peace restored.

- 11/6 Motor Vehicle Theft – 3421 Chicago Rd. (Enterprise Rent-a-Car). The business rented a 2021 Toyota Camry, which the person renting the car failed to return.

- 11/7 Disorderly Conduct – 500 W. Steger Rd. (Shell Steger). Store staff told police a customer had a disagreement with the price of merchandise and began to throw things at the employee. The employee told the subject to leave the store. The subject was gone upon police arrival.

- 11/8 Disorderly Conduct – 3300 Block of Wallace Ave. Verbal dispute between neighbors. Christopher A. Wilson, 32 of Steger caused a breach of the peace by yelling obscenities at his elder neighbors. Wilson was provided a copy of the Local Ordinance, and is to appear in Adjudication.
- 11/8 Fraud – 3100 Block of Florence Ave. Victim reported unauthorized out-of-state credit card transactions. Offender(s) unknown made unauthorized payments to the U.S. Treasury for a tax payment.
- 11/8 Child Custody Dispute, Harassment through Electronic Communications – 3400 Block of S. Kings Rd. Verbal dispute regarding child visitation. The victim reported receiving harassing text messages from the child’s father.
- 11/9 Domestic Battery – 400 Block of W. 34th St. Ledale Tanniehill, 28 of Steger was arrested for Domestic Battery. Tanniehill was processed, and transported to the Will County Adult Detention Facility.
- 11/9 Domestic Dispute – 3300 Block of Butler Ave. Resident did not want his girlfriend on the property due to a verbal altercation. The girlfriend was transported to St James Hospital due to her being highly intoxicated.
- 11/10 Theft of Labor or Services – 3400 Block of Wallace Ave. Anais Espino, 20 of Chicago Heights was arrested for failing to pay for a Taxi from Carpentersville to Steger. Espino was cited and released.
- 11/10 Suspicious Circumstances – 200 Block of Durham Dr. Offender unknown, came to residence looking for a package. The offender is described as a M/B, beard, wearing light colored blue jeans. Camouflage jacket with red writing on back “love kills”. The subject departed in a gold colored 4-door sedan, believed to be a Chevy Impala. Police believe offender(s) are using various addresses to pick up mail & packages obtained from illegal activity.
