The Board of Trustees convened in regular session at 7:00 P.M. on this 1<sup>st</sup> day of July 2024 in the Municipal Building of the Village of Steger, Illinois. Mayor Peterson led all in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 82, SECTION 82-486 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF STEGER, ILLINOIS REGARDING PARKING FOR THE VILLAGE OF STEGER, ILLINOIS.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Steger, Counties of Cook and Will, State of Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/1-1-1, *et seq.*), and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, with full powers to enact ordinances and adopt resolutions for the benefit of the residents of the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor, who is also the President of the Village (the "President") and the Board of Trustees of the Village (with the President, the "Corporate Authorities") are committed to protecting the health, safety and welfare of the Village and its residents; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 11-208 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-208) provides that local authorities shall have the power to regulate the standing or parking of vehicles with respect to streets and highways under their jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Code of Steger, Illinois (the "Village Code") previously enacted regulations related to parking (the "Existing Regulations"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is necessary, advisable and in the best interests of the Village to update the Existing Regulations to provide that it is unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on certain streets during specified times, unless the person obtains a valid resident vehicle sticker or a guest vehicle pass; and

**WHEREAS**, in light of the foregoing, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is necessary, advisable and in the best interests of the Village and its residents to amend Chapter 82, Section 82-486 of the Village Code as set forth herein;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Steger, Counties of Cook and Will, State of Illinois, as follows:

**ARTICLE I.  
IN GENERAL**

**SECTION 1.0: Incorporation Clause.**

The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance as legislative findings.

**SECTION 2.0: Purpose.**

The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Chapter 82, Section 82-486 of the Village Code as set forth below.

**ARTICLE II.  
AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 82, SECTION 82-486 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE  
FOR THE VILLAGE OF STEGER, ILLINOIS**

**SECTION 3.0: Amendment to Chapter 82, Section 82-486 of the Village Code.**

That the Village Code is hereby amended, notwithstanding any provision, ordinance, resolution or Village Code section to the contrary, by amending Chapter 82, Section 82-486 as follows (additions underlined; deletions ~~stricken~~):

**Sec. 82-486. - Resident vehicle sticker required to park on certain streets.**

It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on any of the following streets unless the vehicle conspicuously displays a valid resident vehicle sticker or a valid guest vehicle pass issued in accordance with section 82-487:

- (1) Either side of Kings Road, between 35th Street and Richton Road.
- (2) Either side of William Street, between 35th Street and Richton Road.

- (3) Either side of Ashland Avenue, between 35th Street and Richton Road.
- (4) Either side of John Street, between 35th Street and Craig Court.
- (5) Either side of Sally Drive, between 35<sup>th</sup> Street and Steger Road.
- (6) Either side of 35<sup>th</sup> Street, between Susan Lane and John Street.
- (7) Either side of Jennifer Court.
- (8) Either side of Susan Lane between ~~35th Street and Sally Drive~~ and Barbara Lane.
- (9) Either side of Royal Oak Drive south of Lisa Lane between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.
- (10) Either side of Royal Oak Court between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.

Any person found to be in violation of this section shall be subject to a \$100.00 fine and any vehicle parked in violation of this section shall be subject to be towed without notice in accordance with section 82-572.

**SECTION 3.1: Other Actions Authorized.**

The officers, employees and/or agents of the Village shall take all action necessary or reasonably required to carry out, give effect to and consummate the amendment contemplated by this Ordinance and shall take all action necessary in conformity therewith, including installing and maintaining no parking signs. The officers, employees and/or agents of the Village are specifically authorized and directed to draft and disseminate any and all necessary forms, notices and stickers to be utilized in connection with the intent of this Ordinance.

**ARTICLE III.  
HEADINGS, SAVINGS CLAUSES, PUBLICATION,  
EFFECTIVE DATE**

**SECTION 4.0: Headings.**

The headings of the articles, sections, paragraphs and subparagraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Ordinance nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provision of this Ordinance.



**SECTION 5.0: Severability.**

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision of this Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable and as though not provided for herein, and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect.

**SECTION 6.0: Superseder.**

All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions, rules and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

**SECTION 7.0: Publication.**

A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

**SECTION 8.0: Effective Date.**

This Ordinance shall be effective and in full force ten (10) days after its passage, approval and publication in accordance with applicable law.
