Gayton has previously been trespassed from the business. Gayton was issued Local Ordinance Citations for Trespass and Disorderly Conduct. The victim was provided with information to obtain a Stalking- No Contact Order.
- 1/6 Criminal Trespass, Battery – 0-100 Block of W. 31st St. An acquaintance of the victim's husband came to the residence. The victim told the subject to get off the property and was struck multiple times. Robin V. Myrick, 37 of University Park was arrested for Criminal Trespass and Battery. Myrick was cited and released.
