- 11/25 Domestic Dispute – 3100 Block of Green St. Verbal altercation between family members. Parties separated, peace restored.
- 11/25 Theft – 100 Block of 37<sup>th</sup> PL. Victim told police she had a package delivered to her old residence. When she went to pick it up she couldn't locate it.
- 11/26 Disturbance – 3327 Chicago Rd. (Glass Tap). Physical altercation between two female patrons. Parties were separated prior to police arrival. Report on file.
- 11/26 Domestic Disturbance – 300 Block of W. 35<sup>th</sup> St. Verbal altercation between cohabitants. Parties agreed to separate, peace restored.
- 11/26 Disorderly Conduct – 100 Block of Dorsetshire Dr. A court processor was attempting to serve paperwork, when the resident ordered her off the property before she gets her gun. The processor declined criminal prosecution.

- 11/27 Criminal Trespass – 3327 Chicago Rd. (Glass Tap). Leah R. Morgan, 33 of Lowell, IN. was refusing to leave the bar. Morgan became verbally aggressive, threatening staff when they stopped serving her alcohol. Morgan was given a Trespass Notice, provided a ride to the police department to wait for a friend to pick her up.
- 11/27 Traffic Arrest – 34<sup>th</sup> & Peoria St. Rachel A. Davis, 23 of Steger was stopped for speeding 53 mph in a posted 30 mph zone. Davis was also charged with Driving While License Suspended. Davis's vehicle was towed & impounded, she was cited and released.

- 11/29 Fraud – 23400 Block of S. Kings Rd. Victim reported unauthorized purchases with one of his credit cards.
- 11/30 Disturbance – 0-100 Block of E. 34<sup>th</sup> St. The Reporting Party told police he was parked in the apartment parking lot waiting for a friend, when confronted by one of the tenants.
