- 12/23 Disturbance – 3327 Chicago Rd. (Glass Tap). Two unidentified female patrons attempted to start a fight with another female patron. Staff broke up the altercation. Offenders were gone upon police arrival.
- 12/23 Domestic Battery, Aggravated Battery to a Peace Officer, Resisting/Obstructing – 200 Block of Lakeview Court. The offender, identified as Alexander J. Sloss, 33 of Steger elbowed the victim in the ribs. The victim locked herself and two children in the bedroom. Police made entry and were confronted by Sloss, who pushed and punched officers with a closed fist. The offender was subdued and placed in custody. Sloss was transported to the Police Department, processed and transported to the Will County Adult Detention Facility.
- 12/23 Domestic Dispute – 300 Block of Tiverton Ln. Verbal altercation, officers waited while one of the parties gathered property. Parties separated, peace restored.
- 12/23 Criminal Damage to Property – 3000 Block of Union Ave. Offender unknown threw a brick through the victim's apartment window. TOT Investigations.
- 12/23 Traffic Arrest – 34th & S. Kings Rd. Jayma N. Larkin, 20 of Olympia Fields was arrested for Driving While License Suspended. Larkin's vehicle was towed and impounded. Larkins was cited and released.
- 12/24 Armed Robbery – 3401 Chicago Rd. (7-Eleven). Two offenders, described as a female black and male black, dressed in dark clothing entered the store, displayed a handgun, and stole merchandise and money. The offenders fled in a gray Toyota Camry. There were no injuries from this incident. Police are investigating.
- 12/24 Domestic Dispute – 3400 Block of Green St. Altercation between family members. Parties separated prior to police arrival.
- 12/25 Theft – 3400 Block of S. Kings Rd. Offender unknown stole a license plate off of the victim's 2016 Kia Optima.

- 12/26 Unlawful Discharge of a Firearm – 3500 Block of Morgan. Offender unknown unlawfully discharged a handgun within Village Limits. Police canvased the area, collected evidence, and reviewed video camera footage from the area. There were no reports of injury or damage. Police are investigating.
- 12/27 Traffic Arrest – 31st & Chicago Rd. Marketta N. Smith, 45 of Sauk Village was arrested for Driving While License Suspended. Smith's vehicle was towed and impounded. Smith was cited and released.
- 12/27 Domestic Trouble Crisis Intervention – 400 Block of W. 34th St. The Reporting Party told police she was involved in an altercation with her boyfriend. Parties separated prior to police arrival. The reporting party explained her boyfriend is moving out and did not want the boyfriend's firearm in her apartment. The firearm was turned over to the police for safekeeping.
- 12/28 Unwanted Subject – 81 E. 34th St. (Austin's Tavern). Patron did not have any money to pay for his food and beverages consumed. Police provided transportation for the subject and trespassed him from the establishment.
- 12/28 Aggravated Battery – 3500 Block of Wallace Ave. Physical altercation between acquaintances. During the altercation several of the parties suffered abrasions and lacerations. One person was transported to the hospital to treat her injuries. Police are investigating.
- 12/29 Traffic Arrest – 34th & Innsbruck Ln. Tashaya G. Graves, 26 of Crete was arrested for Driving While License Suspended. Greeves's vehicle was towed and impounded. The offender was cited and released.
