- 2/3 Domestic Battery – Physical altercation between cohabitants. Conflicting statements from involved parties. Unable to substantiate complaints. Prosecution declined, parties separated, peace restored.
- 2/3 Disturbance – 3332 Chicago Rd. (VFW). Staff contacted police and wanted Joseph J. Krolak removed from the establishment. Police escorted Krolak out of the business and provided him a ride home.
- 2/3 Domestic Dispute – 3400 Union Ave. Verbal altercation escalated and both parties threw their drink at each other. Parties separated, peace restored.
- 2/5 Traffic Arrest – 34th & Green St. Marchino Culbreath, 36 was arrested for Driving While License Suspended, Suspended Registration and Operation of Uninsured Motor Vehicle. Culbreath was cited and released.

- 2/8 Aggravated Battery with a Deadly Weapon. Steger Police were notified by St. James Hospital staff that they have a patient that was stabbed at an unknown location in Steger. The victim suffered a non-life threatening injury. Investigation pending.
- 2/8 Aggravated Battery – 500 Block of Richton Rd. Physical altercation between acquaintances. The victim reported being punched and hit with a blunt object, causing a laceration to his head. The offender was gone upon police arrival. The victim was transported to St. James Hospital in Olympia Fields. Investigation pending.
- 2/9 Traffic Arrest – e. 34th PL. & Union Ave. Mark A. Amos, 55 of Chicago Heights was stopped for Disobeying a Stop Sign. A driver's license inquiry revealed Amos's driver's license was suspended. Amos was cited and released. The offender's vehicle was towed and impounded.
- 2/9 Traffic Arrest – 3400 Block of Florence Ave. Police were dispatched to the area for the report of a Hit & Run Accident. The offender struck a parked car and fled to a nearby relative's house. Police made contact with the driver, Sebastian R. Munoz, 25 of Schererville and arrested him for failing to give information after damaging unattended vehicle, Operation of Uninsured Motor Vehicle, and Possession of Cannabis. Munoz was cited and released.
