- 2/24 Criminal Damage to Property – 3400 Block of S. Kings Rd. Offender(s) unknown broke the rear passenger side window on the victim's 2013 Kia Optima. TOT Investigations.
- 2/24 Criminal Damage to Property – 300 Block of W. 35<sup>th</sup> St. Offender(s) unknown broke the rear driver side window on the victim's Hyundai Sedan. TOT Investigations.
- 2/24 Traffic Arrest – 34<sup>th</sup> & Chicago Rd. Neil R. Alexander, 33 of Matteson was stopped for speeding 50 MPH in a posted 30 MPH zone. A status check of the driver indicated that the driver was suspended. Alexander was arrested for Driving While License Suspended and speeding. Alexander was cited and released, and his vehicle was towed and impounded.

- 2/27 Domestic Dispute – 400 Block of W. 34<sup>th</sup> St. Verbal altercation, accusation made from one party reporting a battery. No signs of injury, conflicting statements, unable to substantiate criminal charges. Information provided to obtain an Order of Protection. Parties separated, peace restored.
- 2/28 Assist Fire Department – 3300 Block of Union. Police responded and made contact with the victim and witnesses. The witnesses stated they were knocking on the door and the victim jumped out the first floor window. The witness told police the victim thought someone was after him. The subject was transported to St. Margaret Hospital in Dyer, IN.
- 2/28 Disorderly Conduct – 94 W. Richton Rd. Steger Police Officers responded to a report of a student allegedly in possession of a weapon at Steger School District 194 Columbia Central Middle School. Officers from Steger, Crete and South Chicago Heights responded and worked with the School District to investigate the report. A toy weapon was located and all students involved have been identified. TOT Juvenile Investigation.
