PLEASE DO NOT BRING

- Artificial trees
- Lights, ornaments, tinsel, or stands

FIRE SAFETY REMINDERS

- Never burn trees indoors or in backyards
- Remove dry trees promptly
- Keep heat sources clear
- Follow local fire department guidance
