- 3/7 Domestic Dispute – 3200 Block of Phillips Ave. Altercation between husband and wife. Parties separated prior to police arrival. Information provided to the Crisis Center of South Suburbia.
- 3/7 Domestic Dispute – 3700 Block of Union Ave. Verbal altercation between cohabitants. Information provided to obtain an Order of Protection.
- 3/8 Aggravated Assault, Resisting Arrest, Battery – 300 Block of W. 34th St. Police were dispatched to the area for a well-being check. Resident, Genesis Z. Tate, 25 of Steger threatened officers. While being detained Tate caused bodily harm to a police officer. Tate was issued a Notice to Appear, and transported to St. James Olympia Fields Hospital for evaluation. DCFS contacted.
- 3/8 Traffic Arrest – 34th & Dorsetshire Dr. Police responded to the area for a motor vehicle crash. One of the involved motorists, Timothy A. Cristelli, 37 of Steger was arrested for Driving under the Influence of Alcohol. Cristelli was issued a Cook County notice to Appear and released. The offender's vehicle was towed and impounded.
