- 3/21 Domestic Disturbance – 500 W. Steger Rd. Police were dispatched to the area for a disturbance. Upon arrival, police spoke to the involved parties. One of the involved parties requested to be transported to the hospital for an evaluation.
- 3/22 Loud Noise Complaint – 3200 Block of Hopkins Ave. Police were dispatched to the residence three times, the last being at approximately 2:53 am. The resident Richard R. Stewart, 32 of Steger was arrested for Obstructing Identification, Resisting Obstructing a Peace Officer, and Illegal Operation of Sound System. Stewart was processed, issued a Pre-Trial Notice to Appear, and released.
- 3/22 Disturbance – 0-100 Block of W. 32<sup>nd</sup> St. Verbal altercation between the resident's ex-girlfriend and current girlfriend. Parties were separated prior to police arrival.
- 3/22 Retail Theft – 20 E. 34<sup>th</sup> St. (Party Liquors). Tyler Rodney, 61 of Steger was captured on video surveillance removing a bottle of alcohol without making payment. Rodney was issued a Local Ordinance Citation for Retail Theft and a trespassed from the business.
- 3/23 Domestic Disturbance – 3500 Block of Peoria St. Altercation between cohabitants. Conflicting statements, no supporting evidence or signs of injuries, unable to substantiate complaints.
- 3/23 Violation of Stalking No Contact Order – 3100 Block of Hopkins Ave. Courtney N. Reynolds, 45 of Steger was arrested for Violation of Stalking No Contact Order. Reynolds was processed and transported to the Will County Adult Detention Facility.

- 3/24 Theft – 22331 Cottage Grove Ave. Victim reported someone stole his I-Phone 14 Plus while he was in gym class. TOT school staff and Juvenile Investigations.
- 3/24 Domestic Dispute – 200 Block of #. 34<sup>th</sup> St. Verbal altercation between boyfriend and girlfriend. Parties separated, peace restored.
- 3/25 Domestic Dispute – 300 Block of W. 35<sup>th</sup> St. Verbal altercation between cohabitants. Parties separated, peace restored.
- 3/26 Identity Theft – 300 Block of W. 35<sup>th</sup> St. Offender unknown used the victim's personal information to open an AT&T account. Report generated for AT&T dispute.

- 3/27 Traffic Arrest – 33<sup>rd</sup> & Carpenter St. Police observed a vehicle exceeding the 25 mph speed zone. The motorist disobeyed three stop signs in the residential area. Police stopped the vehicle and made contact with the driver, Brandon S. Callahan, 27 of Aurora. The motorist showed signs of impairment, and open alcohol was located in the vehicle. Callahan refused Field Sobriety and subsequently arrested for Driving under the Influence of Alcohol. Callahan was also cited for Reckless Driving, Driving While License Suspended, and other traffic offenses. The vehicle the offender was driving was towed and impounded. Callahan was issued a Non-Discretionary Pretrial Notice, and released.
