- 4/11 Criminal Damage to Property – 3500 Block of Green St. At approximately 10:15 pm on 4/10/26, the victim heard a loud boom in the rear of her house. The next day she discovered someone had damaged her door.
- 4/12 Domestic Dispute – 0-100 Block of W. 35<sup>th</sup> St. Verbal altercation between cohabitants. Parties advised to separate for the evening, peace restored.
- 4/13 Domestic Dispute – 3100 Block of Halsted St. Verbal altercation between ex-boyfriend and girlfriend. Police stood by while property was removed. Arrangements were made to retrieve other property at later date. Peace restored.
- 4/13 Criminal Defacement – 400 Block of W. 35<sup>th</sup> St. Offenders unknown spray painted graffiti on walls and windows in the apartment complex. TOT Investigations.
- 4/14 Unwanted Subject – 3600 Block of Susan. Resident and family members told police a subject that was allowed to stay at the residence has started drinking again and has become aggressive. Information was provided to obtain an Order of Protection, and explained the eviction process.
