- 3/26 Domestic Disturbance, Criminal Damage to Property – 3000 Block of Butler Ave. Elise K. Harris, 25 of Park Forest fled after damaging the victim’s vehicle. Police located the vehicle westbound 30th Street. Harris refused to stop, disobeyed a stop sign and struck a parked vehicle. Harris was taken into custody and charged with Fleeing & Eluding / Resisting, Criminal Damage to Property and other traffic offenses. Harris was issued a Cook County Notice to Appear and released. The offender’s vehicle was towed and impounded.
- 3/28 Criminal Damage to Property – 3128 Block of Chicago Rd. (State Farm Insurance). Business owner advised someone broke the front window of the business. A metal piece from a vehicle was found inside the business.
- 3/28 Reckless Discharge of a Firearm – 300 Block of W. 34th St. Gregory Duncan, 24 of Steger was arrested for Reckless Discharge of a Firearm, and Aggravated Unlawful Possession of a Weapon. Duncan was processed, and transported to the Will County Adult Detention Facility.
