- 4/25 Domestic Dispute – 300 Block of Wallace Ave. Verbal altercation between cohabitants. Parties separated, peace restored.
- 4/25 Domestic Disturbance – 400 Block of W. 34th St. Victim involved in a verbal altercation with his ex-partner. The argument escalated and started to become physical. Friends removed the subject from the residence.
