- 5/17 Traffic Crash – DUI 34th & Chicago Rd. Police responded to the area for a report of a traffic crash. The vehicle left the scene, and subsequently stopped by a Crete Police Officer. Steger Police responded to the scene and continued the investigation. Motorist Abbey D. Lussing 27, of Steger was arrested for DUI, Leaving the Scene of an Accident, Operation of Uninsured Motor Vehicle, and Suspended Registration. Lussing was issued a Will County Notice to Appear and released. The offender's vehicle was towed and impounded.
- 5/19 Theft – 3700 Block of Union Ave. Victim reported a firearm stolen from his residence. The weapon was recovered by the Dyer, Indiana Police Department. Tot Investigations.
- 5/21 Harassment through Electronic Communication – 94 W. Richton Rd. Victim received a harassing email on her work email. School staff and police are investigating.
- 5/21 Traffic Arrest – 34th & Chicago Rd. Motorist, Donald M. McNeal, 37 of Steger was stopped for disobeying a stop sign. A status check revealed his driver's license was suspended. McNeal was issued a Will County Notice to Appear, cited, and released. The offender's vehicle was towed and impounded.
- 5/22 Disturbance – 300 Block of W. 34th St. The reporting party told police she met a male subject in Matteson and they relocated to her apartment. Both parties were involved in an argument that escalated and became physical. The subject pulled out a gun, fired in an unknown direction and left the apartment. There were no reports of injuries or damage. Police are investigating.
