- 5/2 Harassment through Electronic Communications – 35 W. 34th St. Victim reported receiving harassing and threatening text messages from her daughter's ex-boyfriend. Information provided to obtain a No Stalking Contact Order.
- 5/3 Domestic Battery – 400 Block of W. 34th St. Victim reported being battered by his girlfriend. The girlfriend was gone upon police arrival. The victim was transported to St. James Hospital in Olympia fields for treatment. TOT Investigations.
- 5/3 Domestic Battery – 0-100 Block of E. 30th PL. Victim reported being pushed and scratched by his girlfriend. His girlfriend departed prior to police arrival. Complaints declined by victim.
- 5/4 Domestic Disturbance – 3500 Block of Peoria St. Physical altercation between cohabitants. Both parties refused to cooperate. Mutual combatants, unable to substantiate complaints. Parties advised to stay away from each other for the night.
- 5/4 Disturbance – 3329 Chicago Rd. (Glass Tap). Altercation between patrons in the parking lot. One of the subjects reported being struck in the head by an unknown person but declined medical treatment and complaints. All parties departed without incident.
- 5/5 Lost/Stolen Purse – 11 W. 34th St. (Brown Onion pub). Victim reported she discovered her purse-missing while in the restaurant. Police are investigating.
- 5/5 Identity Theft – 3100 Block of Phillips Ave. Offender unknown used the victim's personal information to open a Verizon account and purchase two iPhones.

- 5/5 Burglary – 3100 Block of Halsted St. Offender(s) unknown made forced entry into the victim's detached garage through a side service door. The victim told police the only thing taken was a bicycle belonging to a friend. TOT Investigations.
- 5/6 Domestic Dispute – 3300 Block of Phillips Ave. Reporting Party told police she was in a verbal altercation with her boyfriend. The boyfriend drove her vehicle into a ditch, activating the airbags. The boyfriend was not on scene upon police arrival.
- 5/6 Residential Burglary – 3300 Block of Wallace Ave. Unknown offender(s) made entry into the victim's garage through a window. A brick was thrown through the victim's Ford F-150 window that was parked in the garage. Money and personal items were taken from the vehicle.
- 5/6 Theft – 0-100 Block of 33rd PL. The victim took her vehicle to a local resident who was hired to paint her car. Sometime in his possession one of the license plates were stolen.
- 5/7 Theft by Deception – 0-100 Block of W. 32nd St. Offenders obtained money through fraudulent means. Victim received a message on Facebook Messenger involving a cash disbursement. The victim was instructed to send money for the taxes, using Apple Pay cards. The victim sent the cards not realizing it was fraudulent. TOT Investigations.
- 5/7 Traffic Arrest – 33rd & Chicago Rd. Motorist, Felicia M. Harvey, 60 of Chicago was stopped for a traffic infraction. A status check revealed Harvey's license was suspended. Harvey was issued citations, a notice to appear and released. The offender's vehicle was towed and impounded.
- 5/8 Domestic Dispute – 3500 Peoria St. Boyfriend would not allow his girlfriend inside of the residence or allow her to pick up personal property. Parties separated, peace restored.
- 5/8 Local Ordinance Violation – 3700 Block of Park Ave. Police stopped a motorist for operating a 250cc dirt bike on a public street. The subject was issued a local ordinance citation for operating a non-highway vehicle on the roadway.
