- 6/13 Traffic Arrest – 300 Block of Sangamon St. Police were dispatched to the area for a Hit and Run Crash. Police were able to locate the vehicle using Flock Plate Recognition Cameras. The driver, Delilah A. Navaro, 25 of Chicago was taken into custody. Navaro was charged with Leaving the Scene of an Accident, Driving While License was Suspended, Illegal Transportation of Alcohol, and Possession of Cannabis. Navaro was processed, issued a Notice to Appear, and released. The offender's vehicle was towed and impounded.
- 6/14 Domestic Dispute – 22500 Block of Sherman Rd. Verbal altercation between family members. Parties agreed to distance themselves for a few days. Peace restored.
- 6/14 Domestic Dispute – 3000 Block of Phillips Ave. Verbal altercation between cohabitants. Police mitigated a peaceful resolution. Parties separated, peace restored. Information forwarded to the Crisis Center of South Suburbia.
