- 5/30 Harassment through Electronic Communication, Non-consensual Dissemination of Sexual Explicit Digitalized Material – 35 W. 34th St. Victim reported a family member used her phone to download explicit pictures and videos without consent. TOT Investigations.
- 5/30 Domestic Dispute, Criminal Damage to Property – 3500 Block of Peoria St. Fayla R. Rodriguez, 26 of Steger punctured a tire on her boyfriend's vehicle. Rodriguez was arrested for Criminal Damage to Property and Resisting a Peace Officer. The offender was processed, issued a Notice to Appear, and released.
- 5/31 Disorderly Conduct, Criminal Trespass – 3507 Chicago Rd. (Shell Gas Station). Customer, Marco A. Villarreal, 43 of Chicago Heights caused a breach of the peace. Villarreal was issued a Trespass Notice and advised not to return.
- 6/1 Harassment through Electronic Communications – 0-100 Block of W. 30th PL. Victim reported being harassed on-line. The unknown offender's on-line identity was blocked. Report on file.
