- 7/11 Hit & Run Accident – 23000 Block of Ashland Ave. Motorist, Fabian D. Corona, 27 of Sauk Village was involved in a property damage accident. Corona left the scene without reporting the crash. Corona was later located and cited for Leaving the Scene of an Accident, Failure to Report Crash to Police, and Expired Registration. Corona was issued a Non-Discretionary Pretrial Notice, and released.
- 7/11 Local Ordinance Violation – 22300 Block of Cottage Grove. Police responded to a call involving fireworks. Police made contact with residents and issued a local ordinance citation.
- 7/12 Hit & Run Accident – 3327 Chicago Rd. (Glass Tap). Police responded to the liquor establishment reference a disturbance call. Police witnessed motorist, Jeron C. Mason, 31 of Chicago reverse his vehicle into a parked 2026 Chevy Silverado and flee the scene. Steger Police was assisted by Crete and South Chicago Police Departments stop the vehicle. Mason was arrested, issued citations for Leaving the Scene of an Accident, Reckless Driving, and an equipment violation. Mason was provided a notice to appear and released. The vehicle was towed and impounded.
