- 6/27 Aggravated Domestic Battery – 100 Block of E. 34th St. Victim came to the Steger Police Department to report a battery. The victim told police her husband pushed and strangled her. Referred to the Crisis Center of South Suburbia. TOT Investigations.
- 6/28 Domestic Dispute – 3600 Block of John St. Verbal altercation between husband and wife escalated and became physical. Mutual combatants, unable to substantiate complaints. Parties separated, peace restored.
- 6/28 Traffic Arrest – 3400 Block of Union Ave. Motorist, Trinity L. Hunt, 22 of South Chicago Heights was stopped for an equipment violation. Status check revealed she was operating a motor vehicle without a valid driver's license.
- 6/29 Traffic Arrest – 34th & Union Ave. Police responded to a property damage crash, and identified both drivers. A status check confirmed one of the drivers, Yeferson F. Alonzo-Chinchilla, 21 of Steger was operating a motor vehicle without a valid driver's license. Alonzo was cited, issued a notice to appear, and released.
- 6/29 Harassment through Electronic Communications – 35 W. 34th St. The victim came to the police department and reported her ex-boyfriend created a fictitious Instagram account with her information. The offender threatened to release more information about the victim if she does not rekindle the relationship. TOT Investigations.
- 6/29 Domestic Battery – 300 Block of W. 34th St. Physical altercation between family members. Parties separated prior to police arrival. Conflicting statements, unable to substantiate complaints. TOT Investigations and D.C.F.S.

- 6/30 Battery – 22331 Cottage Grove Ave (Bloom Trail H.S.). Staff member intervened in a physical altercation between three students. One of the students attempted to kick the victim in the face and struck the employee's arm. TOT Investigations.
- 7/1 Attempt Motor Vehicle Theft, CDP – 3600 Block of Green St. Unknown Offender(S) broke the window on the victim's Kia Forte and gained access to the passenger compartment. The offender(s) damaged the steering column in an attempt to remove the vehicle. TOT Investigations.
- 7/1 Domestic Disturbance – 3500 Block of Peoria St. Verbal altercation between husband and wife. Argument escalated and became physical. Conflicting statement, no injuries or evidence to substantiate criminal complaints. Information provided to obtain an Order of Protection.
- 7/1 Motor Vehicle Theft – Police were dispatched to the area of a report of a suspicious vehicle. Witness observed a Hyundai Sonata driving in the area, he began to follow, the vehicle stopped and two male juveniles fled from the vehicle. The steering column and the rear window was damaged. Police made notification to the owner. TOT Investigations.
- 7/2 Motor Vehicle Theft – 3400 Block of Kings Rd. Victim reported his 2026 Honda CRV Stolen. There was broken glass discovered where the vehicle was parked. The vehicle was entered into the Law Enforcement Agencies Data System as stolen. Tot Investigations.
- 7/2 Traffic / Warrant Arrest – 3400 Block of Halsted Blvd. Motorist, Patrick M. Mayhew, 28 of Crete was stopped for speeding 51 mph in a posted 30 mph zone. Status check revealed an active warrant out of Will County. Mayhew was arrested, cited for Speeding, Suspended Registration, Operation of Uninsured Motor Vehicle, Expired Registration and Unlawful Transportation of Alcohol. Mayhew was transported to the Will County Adult Detention Facility. The offender's vehicle was towed and impounded.
- 7/3 Domestic Battery – 0-100 Block of McKinley Ave. Samuel Hood, 42 of Steger was arrested for grabbing his girlfriend and throwing her against the refrigerator. Hood was arrested, processed and transported to the Will County Adult Detention Facility.
- 7/3 Criminal Damage to Property – 3100 Block of Wallace Ave. Victim reported Damage to her 2014 Hyundai Sonata. The rear passenger window was broken.

- 7/3 Domestic Dispute – 300 Block of W. 35th St. Verbal altercation between subjects previously involved in a dating relationship. Parties separated, peace restored.
- 7/3 Criminal Trespass – 3507 Chicago Rd. (Shell Gas Station). Myles E. Johnson, 30 of Chicago Heights, receiving prior notice of trespass entered the store without legal justification. Johnson was issued a Local Ordinance citation for Trespass.
