- 4/27 Motor Vehicle Theft – 100 Block of Lake Hill Dr. Offender(s) unknown stole the victim's 2016 Dodge Durango from the victim's driveway in the early morning of Saturday, April 27th. Police are investigating.
- 4/27 Driving while License Suspend, Unlawful Use of Weapon – 3400 Block of Chicago Rd. Nathan M. Gonzales, 23 of Steger was stopped for disobeying a traffic control device. Upon further investigation it was determined Gonzales driver's license was suspended. While conducting a search incident to arrest a loaded Glock handgun was found under the driver's seat. In addition to the traffic offenses, Gonzales was charged with Aggravated Unlawful Use of a Weapon. Gonzales was arrested, processed and transported to the Will County Adult Detention Facility. The offender's vehicle was towed and impounded.
- 4/28 Motor Vehicle Theft – 100 Block of Lake Hill Dr. Offender(s) unknown stole the victim's 2018 Dodge Durango from the victim's driveway. The Durango was recovered in the 3100 Block of Loverock Ave. TOT Investigations.
- 4/28 Disturbance – 0-100 Block of 36th St. Verbal altercation between acquaintances. Parties separated, peace restored.
