- 5/11 Domestic Dispute – 400 Block of 34th St. Verbal altercation between cohabitants. Parties separated, peace restored.

- 5/12 Domestic Battery – 3500 Block of Wallace Ave. Victim reported being choked and her hair ripped out by her ex-boyfriend. The victim's ex-boyfriend was gone upon police arrival. TOT Investigations.
