The job was not completed by the agreed date, and has had difficulty contacting the person doing the work. Contact was made with a family member and an extension was agreed upon to pick up the property. Intimidation – 20 W. 34th St. (Old Plank Trail Bank). A disgruntle customer, Antonio 5/25 Lozano, 59 of Steger telephoned and threatened to shoot up the bank. Lozano was arrested for Intimidation, processed, and transported to the Will County Adult Detention Facility. Theft – 400 Block of W. 34th St. Victim reported receiving notification via email 5/25 that a package had been delivered. The victim checked the designated drop off are for the package, but met with negative results.
