- 8/3 Domestic Disturbance – Verbal altercation between boyfriend & girlfriend. Information provided to obtain an Order of Protection. Report on file.
- 8/4 Deceptive Practice – 3000 Block of Union Ave. Broker contacted the police after inspecting a house he just sold. Upon inspection, he discovered unauthorized people living in the house. Police spoke to the residents, who had conflicting documents, TOT Investigations.
- 8/4 Criminal Trespass – 3327 Chicago Rd. (Glass Tap). Subject was asked to leave by staff several times, but he disregarded their request and kept returning. Police escorted the subject off the property and warned him if he returned would be arrested for Criminal Trespass.
- 8/4 Aggravated Battery to a Fireman – 35 W. 34th St. While transporting a patient to the hospital, he grabbed and scratched the fireman's face and neck. The subject was transported to St. James Hospital in Olympia Fields. TOT Investigations, charges pending.
- 8/4 Loud Noise Complaint, Battery – 200 Block of Lakeview Ct. Police received a complaint for a loud party. Police responded and spoke to the homeowner. The resident advised she would keep the noise down. Police returned after receiving more complaints. While on scene, three eighteen year old females told police an unknown offender sprayed them with pepper spray. The victims refused complaints. The victims were treated by the Steger Fire Department, and released. The guests departed, and the owner was issued a Local Ordinance Violation for the noise violation.
- 8/5 Harassment through Electronic Communication – 23100 Wentworth Ave. Police met with representatives of the church, who reported receiving threatening phone calls and text messages. Police are investigating.

- 8/5 Domestic Battery – 0-100 Block of W. 35th PL. Victim reported being struck in the shoulder with a closed fist by her boyfriend, Ramiro G. Cuevas-Chavez, 31 of Steger. Cuevas-Chavez was arrested, processed, and transported to the Will County Adult Detention Facility.
- 8/6 Criminal Trespass – 3401 Green St. (7-Eleven). Staff contacted police reference a subject banned from the property, has returned. Michael A. Cremer, 34 of Crete was issued a Local Ordinance Citation for Criminal Trespass.
- 8/6 Burglary to Motor Vehicle – 37 E. 34th St. Offender unknown entered the victim's unsecured 2008 Kia Van, and removed his cellphone.
- 8/6 Domestic Dispute – 3300 Block of Butler Ave. Verbal altercation between cohabitants. Peace restored.
- 8/8 Harassment through Electronic Communication – 81 E. 34th St. Victim reported an ex-neighbor stole her cellphone years ago and has been able to access her devices network. Information provided for a No Contact Order.
- 8/8 Domestic Trouble – 3500 Block of Halsted St. Victim was involved in a verbal altercation with his ex-wife. Altercation escalated, his ex-wife through a liquid beverage at his vehicle. Parties separated, report on file.
- 8/8 Computer Tampering – 0-100 Block of 36th St. Offender accessed the victim's computer, causing loss to the user of that computer. The offender accessed Facebook and the victim's email. Police are investigating.
- 8/9 Criminal Damage to Property – 3600 Florence Ave. Victim discovered, an unknown offender broke the windshield on his 1999 Jeep TJ Sport, by methods unknown.
- 8/9 Domestic Battery – 3400 Wallace Ave. Verbal altercation between boyfriend and girlfriend escalated and a physical altercation ensued. The incident resulted in the arrest of Kevin L. Cantway, 33 of Steger. Cantway was processed and transported to the Will County Adult Detention Facility.
- 8/9 Traffic Arrest – 35th & Butler Ave. Andres Garduza Salas, 48 of Chicago Was arrested for No Valid Driver's License, Suspended Registration, and Operation of Uninsured Motor Vehicle. Salas was cited and released. The offender's vehicle was towed and impounded.
