- 7/18 Domestic Dispute – 3400 Block of Kings Rd. Verbal altercation between cohabitants. One of the parties relocated to a family member's residence. Information provided to obtain an Order of Protection.
- 7/18 Disturbance – 3325 Chicago Rd. (Little Caesars). A discontent patron was upset due to her pizza being burnt. The business made a new pizza but the patron was not satisfied. The patron asked for a refund, the business complied. The patron was informed the refund would be placed back on her debit card. The patron began to yell, causing a scene. The patron was trespassed from the business.
- 7/19 Disturbance – 3327 Chicago Rd. (Glass Tap). Employee was fired for her behavior, began to throw bottles in business causing a disturbance. The subject was trespassed from the liquor establishment, and provided a ride to her residence.
- 7/20 Aggravated Fleeing & Eluding – 500 Block of Steger Rd. Police observed a stolen vehicle heading eastbound from Kings Rd. The motorist accelerated, disobeyed three stop signs. Police attempted to stop the motorist but met with negative results. TOT Investigations.
- 7/20 Theft – 3500 Block of Halsted Blvd. Victim told police someone removed his GT 20" bicycle from the driveway. The victim valued the bicycle at \$350.00.
- 7/21 Aggravated Battery, Resisting / Obstructing a Peace Officer – 20 E. 34th St. (Party Liquors. Patron, identified as Jon B. Anderson, 59 of Chicago was arrested for striking an employee and a striking and choking another customer. The offender was located by police and began fleeing on foot. Police gave pursuit, caught the subject and placed him into custody. Anderson was processed, provided a Will County Notice to Appear, and released.

- 7/21 Animal Complaint – 3400 Block of Phillips Ave. While the victim was walking her dog, a Pit Bull Mix ran across the street and attacked her dog. The owner of the dog was issued Local Ordinance citations Dangerous Dog Running at Large, and Dog Bike.
- 7/21 Disturbance, Warrant Arrest = 3500 Block of Wallace Ave. Police were dispatched to the area for a report of a disturbance. A status check revealed one of the involved subjects, A.J. Bibbs, 49 of Steger had an active warrant. Bibbs was arrested, processed, and transported to the Will County Adult Detention Facility.
- 7/22 Domestic Dispute – 3500 Block of Ashland Ave. Verbal altercation between husband and wife. Information provided to obtain an Order of Protection.
- 7/22 Motor Vehicle Theft – 3700 Block of Park Ave. Offender(s) unknown stole the victim's 2020 Honda Accord. The vehicle was later recovered in Chicago Heights. Police are investigating.
- 7/22 Telephone Harassment – 100 Block of W. 34th St. Victim reported receiving numerous harassing phone calls from an acquaintance. Report on file.
- 7/22 Domestic Dispute – 3100 Block of Wallace Ave. Verbal altercation between cohabitants. Both parties agreed to stay in separate areas of the residence. Referred to the Crisis Center of South Suburbia.
- 7/22 Retail Theft – 3507 Chicago Rd. (Shell Gas Station). Employee reported, intoxicated male subject removed the tag on a pair of sunglasses. The subject was told to leave by another customer.
- 7/23 Criminal Damage to Property – 0-100 Block of 36th PL. The victim reported damage to his 2019 Dodge Caravan.
- 7/23 Traffic Arrest – 36th & Emerald. Police stopped a juvenile riding a dirt bike. The motorist was cited for No Valid Driver's License, and Operation of Uninsured Motor Vehicle.
