- 7/25 Trespassing – 3501 Phillips Ave. Two juveniles were escorted from the property for failing to abide by the conspicuously posted fest rules.
- 7/25 Disorderly Conduct – 3501 Phillips Ave. Police were notified of a highly intoxicated subject in the carnival fairway. Police made contact with Glen A. Hannah, 66 of Park Forest. While family members were attempting to escort Hannah from the fest, he caused a breach of the peace by yelling obscenities. Police informed Hannah he was being placed in custody for Disorderly Conduct. Hannah began to resist, was taken to the ground and handcuffed. Hannah was escorted from the fest grounds, issued a Will County Notice to Appear, and released.
- 7/25 Public Indecency, Disorderly Conduct – 3501 Phillips Ave. Employee, Marcus A. Platero-Lopez, 20 of New York was issued Local Ordinance citation for exposing himself under a carnival ride. The subject told police he was going to the bathroom, due to him being unable to leave the area. Platero was removed from the carnival grounds.
- 7/25 Telephone Harassment – 3100 Block of Hopkins Ave. Victim reported receiving harassing phone calls from an acquaintance. Police made contact with the subject, who advised the calls were accidental. Subject was advised not to have any contact.
- 7/26 Recovered Stolen Motor Vehicle – 3400 Block of Kings Rd. While on routine patrol, police discovered a 2022 Honda Accord with damage to the driver side door handle. Status check confirmed the vehicle was stolen out of South Holland. The vehicle was towed from the scene, TOT South Holland Police Department.
- 7/26 Domestic Dispute – 3000 Block of Sangamon St. Verbal altercation between husband and-wife. Parties separated, peace restored. Referred to the Crisis Center of South Suburbia.

- 7/26 Disorderly Conduct – 3501 Phillips Ave. Police observed a group of juveniles arguing in the area of the carnival. One juvenile was yelling obscenities towards another subject. The juvenile was issued a Local Ordinance citation for Disorderly Conduct, and escorted off the property.
- 7/26 Fight, Disorderly Conduct – 3501 Phillips Ave. Police responded to a physical altercation involving two female juveniles. The juveniles were issued Local Ordinance citations for Disorderly Conduct/Fighting. Subjects were processed,, trespassed from the fest, and released to their parents.
- 7/26 Battery – 3231 Chicago Rd. Victim reported being battered by an acquaintance, later identified as Alicia D. Rivera, 28 of Steger. Rivera was issued a Local Ordinance citation for fighting.
- 7/26 Theft – 3200 Block of Hopkins Ave. Victim reported someone entered her driveway and stole a Maxshot Electric Scooter, valued at \$300.00. TOT Investigations.
- 7/27 Motor Vehicle Theft – 0-100 Block of E. 34th St. Offender unknown stole the victim's 2021 Honda Accord. The vehicle was parked in the victim's rear driveway off the alley at the time of occurrence. TOT Investigations. The vehicle was recovered in Chicago Heights.
- 7/27 Criminal Damage to Property – 3400 Union Ave. (Mobile Gas Station). The victim stated while at the gas pumps, a male and female were involved in a physical altercation at the gas pump next to him. One of the subjects threw an object shattering his rear window. The subjects entered their vehicle and drove away. Police are investigating.
- 7/29 Domestic Dispute – 3400 Block of Sally Dr. Verbal altercation between cohabitants. Information provided to obtain an Order of Protection. Parties separated, peace restored.
- 7/31 Motor Vehicle Theft – 3200 Block of Union Ave. Victim reported his 2025 Honda CR-V stolen. The vehicle was listed in the Law Enforcement Agencies Data System as stolen. TOT Investigations.

- 7/31 Traffic Arrest – 34th & Union Ave. Motorist, Cari L Bleifield, 49 of Richton Park was stopped for disobeying the stop sign at 35th & Union Ave. Status check revealed Bleifield was operating a vehicle with a suspended driver's license. Bleifield was cited, provided a Non-Discretionary Pretrial Notice, and released. The offender's vehicle was towed and impounded.
- 7/31 Violation of Order of Protection – 3400 Block of Sally Dr. Offender messaged a protected party in violation of the Order of Protection. Police made contact with the offender to turn himself in. Police to follow up.
