- 8/8 Suspended Registration – 34th & Sally Dr. Motorist, George W. Safo, 22 of Crete was stopped for driving 50 mph in a posted 30 mph zone. Status check revealed Safo was operating his vehicle with suspended registration for noninsurance. Safo was cited and released. The offender's vehicle was towed from the scene.
- 8/8 Domestic Disturbance – 100 Block of E. 31st St. Altercation between family members. Parties separated upon police arrival. Two of the involved subjects were released to a family member, peace restored. Referred to the Crisis Center of South Suburbia.
- 8/9 Recovered Stolen Motor Vehicle – 3700 Block of Green St. Police were dispatched to the area for a suspicious vehicle. Upon arrival, police conducted a status check on the unoccupied 2019 Honda Accord. The status check revealed the vehicle was reported stolen out of Park Forest. The vehicle was towed from scene, TOT Park Forest Police.
- 8/9 Criminal Trespass to Motor Vehicle, Criminal Damage to Motor Vehicle. Unknown offender(s) entered the victim's unsecured 2020 Honda Accord while it was parked and unattended in the driveway. The offender(S) rummaged through the vehicle, but the victim was unable to determine if anything was taken. The offender(s) tampered with the ignition making the key fob inoperable. Police made contact with the subject, disarmed and secured his weapon. The subject told police he pulled his gun because the complainant threatened to get his gun out of his car.
